# Heraklion, Greece

Heraklion is close to the ruins of the palace of Knossos, which in Minoan times was the largest centre of population on Crete. Though there is no archaeological evidence of it, Knossos may well have had a port at the site of Heraklion as long ago as 2000 BC. The present city of Heraklion was founded in 824 by the Saracens who had taken over the island from the Eastern Roman Empire. They built a moat around the city for protection, and named the city Rabd-alhandaq ("Castle of the Moat"). In 1204, the city was bought by the Republic of Venice for the Crusaders of the Fourth Crusade restoring the deposed Eastern Roman Emperor Isaac II Angelus to his throne. In 1898, the Cretan State was created, under Ottoman suzerainty, with Prince George of Greece as its High Commissioner. At this time, the city was renamed 'Heraklion', after the Roman port of Heracleum ('Heracles' city"), whose exact location is unknown. In 1913, with the rest of Crete Heraklion was incorporated into the Kingdom of Greece.
