From the Navigator.

After the Gibraltar Straits last night Queen Elizabeth transited the Gulf of Cadiz and made her approaches to the pilot station. Upon entering the bay we altered our course to starboard staying inside the main channel before lining up on the leads to pass between the breakwaters and into clam harbour waters. Using all three bow thrusters and both electrically driven azipods we manoeuvred alongside the cruise pier, made fast our mooring lines and rigged our gangways ready for our stay.

Cadiz is the oldest continuously-inhabited (early 12th century) city in the Iberian Peninsula and possibly all southwestern Europe, has been a principal home port of the Spanish Navy since the accession of the Spanish Bourbons in the 18th century. Despite its unique site, on a narrow slice of land surrounded by the sea Cadiz is, in most respects, a typically Andalusian city with a wealth of attractive vistas and well-preserved historical landmarks. Behind is the 18th century cathedral (El Nueva) and the view from the top is worth the long climb up its internal stairs. The narrow streets of the old town below are lined by tall Moorish style houses with flower-decked balconies mixed in amongst some small shops and tapas bars.

Nautical fact of the day.

Radar.

Radar is the abbreviation of "Radio Direction And Range" and it's a device for detecting objects by sending out pulses of radio waves; if these strike anything they are reflected back and the time taken for these echoes to return is measured. As the speed of radio waves is known, this time can be automatically translated into the distance of the object. Direction is given by the direction in which the transmitting aerial points at the time. By the 1940's warships were using radar for shadowing an enemy and providing ranges for gunnery. After the war radar sets were installed in merchant ships as aids to navigation and for the prevention of collision.

Officer Profile: Food & Beverage Manager: Jeffrey Morgan

Jeff was born in Brynmawr, in the old county of Breconshire but spent most of his school years in Porthcawl, and 2 years at catering college at Bridgend. Jeff joined QE2 in 1978, as an assistant cook; After a short spell on a cargo ship Jeff rejoined QE2 in early 1986. He then left the kitchens in 1987 and joined the Provisions team to learn a different side of the catering business. He then moved to the Cunard Princess while she was on charter to the American Government during the first Gulf War before again returning to QE2. Jeff was seconded ashore in late 2008 to assist with the closedown of QE2 for when she arrived in Dubai, Leaving QE2 in Dubai he took up his new position as F&B Manager on Queen Victoria, and then in October 2009 Queen Mary 2. He has now completed a full circle by being appointed F&B Manager on the new Queen Elizabeth. A couple of highlights for Jeff in recent years was being introduced to the Queen on board QE2 and the Duchess of Cornwall on Queen Victoria. Jeff is married with two children Rhys and Erin. He met his wife Julie on board QE2 in 1988, they now reside in Poole, Dorset. Jeff has always been a keen cyclist and after many trips to Europe and one to Canada, He embarked with a work colleague on a trip to the Great Wall of China. In 1989 after leaving the QE2 in Singapore they cycled to the Great Wall and then back to join the QE2 in Japan. They covered just over 1600 miles, through 5 countries and raised nearly \$2000 for the QE2 charity. Jeff has also completed a free fall parachute course as well as many other adventurous activities and still lives to tell the tale!
