What to Wear: Smart Attire.

We ask that you wear smart attire in most of our bars, restaurants, and entertainment venues. Smart trousers with a shirt and jacket for gentlemen; tie is optional. Ladies, blouses and skirts or stylish trousers and dresses are welcome. Please note Non-ripped jeans are appropriate, but please refrain from wearing shorts, sports attire, swim wear or sleeveless t-shirts outside of the gym, spa and deck spaces.

Hand antibacterial units on the gangway.

We encourage all guests to assist us in maintaining a healthy ship by using the hand antibacterial units that are located at the gangway.

Safety and security ashore.

Whilst we do not wish to restrict your movements ashore today, we do suggest taking the following precautions:

- ◆ Do not stray from the main tourist areas.
- ◆ Do not wear any jewellery that is likely to attract attention.
- ◆ Be careful to secure personal possessions in pockets, wallets and handbags as pickpockets can operate in all cities.
- ◆ We advise you to be careful if you are taking any high value items, including cameras ashore.
- ◆ Maintain an awareness of your surroundings at all times.

In the unlikely event of you becoming a victim of a crime ashore please ask to see the Security Officer on your return to the ship

Health advice.

In order to prevent any incidences of viral gastroenteritis (diarrhoea and vomiting) on board, we would respectfully advise our guests to be careful with their personal hygiene, particularly hand washing during their time ashore. If eating and drinking ashore please look for an establishment that appears well maintained and clean and only consume food that has been freshly and thoroughly cooked. It is recommended that you take care when ordering salads which are often washed in local tap water and only drink water from unopened sealed bottles and without ice.

Crew emergency drill.

At 10.15am this morning alarms will be sounded and broadcasts made as the crew are exercised in their emergency duties. During this exercise limited guest services will be provided. Part of the exercise involves checking guest staterooms to ensure that they have been evacuated. If you prefer not to be disturbed, display the 'Privacy Please' notice prior to the start of the drill. For the duration of the crew drill, we kindly request that guests keep clear of the outside area of the boat deck. Guests are encouraged to broaden their knowledge of maritime safety by watching the programme shown on TV Channel 48 between 9.00am and 12.00pm.

Spanish IVA (VAT).

Spanish IVA (VAT) at a rate of 10% is payable on all bar charges, select dining cover charges and room service charges whilst our ships are located within 12 nautical miles in Spanish territorial waters (i.e. during the times when we are entering and exiting Spanish ports as well as the time we are alongside in Spanish ports). Prices displayed in our bars, restaurants and room service menus are exclusive of this tax, therefore an additional 10% will be added to all bar charges, select dining cover charges and room service charges whilst our ships are in Spanish territorial waters. The Spanish IVA (VAT) element will be itemised separately on your receipt.

From the Navigator.



After heading south across the Bay of Biscay throughout yesterday the Queen Victoria made her final approaches towards La Coruña. The city is the site of the Roman Tower of Hercules, which is a lighthouse that has been in continuous operation for nearly 2,000 years and is located on the peninsula about 2.5km from the city. Queen Victoria will lie alongside for the day before slipping her lines and exiting the harbor bound for our next port of call, Cadiz.

In the port of La Coruña, Spain.

All Aboard Time: 4.30pm

Corunna (called A Coruña in Galician language) is a Spanish region located in the north western corner of the country. It is part of the Spanish autonomous community of Galicia, a region of vast green landscapes with a rich Celtic and Roman heritage which still keeps a mystic and magic allure today. Temperatures here are moderate although it can be quite rainy. The capital of this Spanish province also bears the name of A Coruña. A city, surrounded by the ocean that has been the point of departure for different people and cultures for over 2,000 years which have left their legacy of legends, myths and history in each corner of the town. The city is also a busy commercial port of the Atlantic from which agricultural goods produced in the region are distributed. You must visit Santiago de Compostela, a beautiful town which welcomes thousands of pilgrims every year. The city's cathedral is the destination of a famous medieval pilgrimage route, the way of St. James (in Spanish the Camino de Santiago). An irregularly shaped peninsula extends 2 kilometres north out to the city's World Heritage-listed Roman lighthouse, the Torre de Hércules. The Paseo Marítimo, a wonderful 13 kilometre walkway and bike path, runs all the way from the port, around the peninsula, along the ocean beaches and on out to the west.
