## What to Wear: Smart Attire.

We ask that you wear smart attire in most of our bars, restaurants, and entertainment venues. Smart trousers with a shirt and jacket for gentlemen; tie is optional. Ladies, blouses and skirts or stylish trousers and dresses are welcome. If you prefer to spend tonight in more relaxed attire, feel free to dress more casually in the following venues: Lido Buffet, Golden Lion Pub, Casino, Winter Garden and Yacht Club. Please note Non-ripped jeans are appropriate, but please refrain from wearing shorts, sports attire, swim wear or sleeveless t-shirts outside of the gym, spa and deck spaces.

## Spanish IVA (VAT).

Spanish IVA (VAT) at a rate of 10% is payable on all bar charges, select dining cover charges and room service charges whilst our ships are located within 12 nautical miles in Spanish territorial waters (i.e. during the times when we are entering and exiting Spanish ports as well as the time we are alongside in Spanish ports). Prices displayed in our bars, restaurants and room service menus are exclusive of this tax, therefore an additional 10% will be added to all bar charges, select dining cover charges and room service charges whilst our ships are in Spanish territorial waters. The Spanish IVA (VAT) element will be itemised separately on your receipt.

## Guest identification cards.

Please be aware that your Guest ID card (ship's identification card) is magnetised. These cards can easily become demagnetised if they are held next to another magnet, for example a credit card, magnets on a handbag, mobile phones, cameras, or if two identification cards are held next to one another. If you require any assistance visit the Purser's Office on deck 1 in the Grand Lobby.

## Hand antibacterial units on the gangway.

We encourage all guests to assist us in maintaining a healthy ship by using the hand antibacterial units that are located at the gangway.

## Safety and security ashore.

Whilst we do not wish to restrict your movements ashore today, we do suggest taking the following precautions:

- Do not stray from the main tourist areas.
- Do not wear any jewellery that is likely to attract attention.
- Be careful to secure personal possessions in pockets, wallets and handbags as pickpockets can operate in all cities.
- We advise you to be careful if you are taking any high value items, including cameras ashore.
- Maintain an awareness of your surroundings at all times.

In the unlikely event of you becoming a victim of a crime ashore please ask to see the Security Officer on your return to the ship.

## Health advice.

In order to prevent any incidences of viral gastroenteritis (diarrhoea and vomiting) on board, we would respectfully advise our guests to be careful with their personal hygiene, particularly hand washing during their time ashore. If eating and drinking ashore please look for an establishment that appears well maintained and clean and only consume food that has been freshly and thoroughly cooked. It is recommended that you take care when ordering salads which are often washed in local tap water and only drink water from unopened sealed bottles and without ice.

## Water conservation.

Water is a very precious commodity on a ship. Fuel is consumed while running our sea water evaporators, therefore we ask you to take extra care in avoiding any wastage. Please do not let taps run unnecessarily and report any leakages to your Stateroom Steward/ Stewardess. Please do not pour excess shampoos or detergents down the sinks or showers as all our grey water is discharged into the sea. We thank you for your cooperation and understanding.

## Climate Control.

The temperature within your stateroom/suite may be adjusted to suit your preferences by setting your thermostat. To keep the stateroom/suite temperature constant we recommend keeping your balcony door closed whenever possible.

# Daily Programme.

## From the Navigator.



In the early hours of this morning Queen Victoria reduced her speed to embark her local pilot shortly before entering the buoyed channel. With the expert assistance of our pilot, Queen Victoria was then navigated into the harbour and alongside her berth here in Cadiz. Cadiz has been regarded by many as the oldest continuously inhabited city in Western Europe and has been a principal home port of the Spanish Navy since the 18th century. It has more than 100 watchtowers, including the iconic Torre Tavira, which was traditionally used for spotting ships

## In the port of Cadiz, Spain.

### All Aboard Time: 5.30pm.

Cádiz is a city and port in south western Spain. It is the capital of the Cádiz province, one of eight which make up the autonomous community of Andalusia. Cádiz, the oldest continuously - inhabited city in Spain and one of the oldest in western Europe, has been a principal home port of the Spanish Navy since the accession of the Spanish Bourbons in the eighteenth century. The city is a member of the Most Ancient European Towns Network. It is also the site of the University of Cádiz. Despite its unique site - on a narrow slice of land surrounded by the sea - Cádiz is, in most respects, a typically Andalusian city with a wealth of attractive vistas and well - preserved historical landmarks. The older part of Cádiz within the remnants of the city walls is commonly referred to as the Old Town (Spanish: Casco Antiguo). It is characterised by the antiquity of its various quarters (barrios), among them El Pópulo, La Viña, and Santa María, which present a marked contrast to the newer areas of town. While the Old City's street plan consists of narrow winding alleys connecting large plazas, newer areas of Cádiz typically have wide avenues and more modern buildings. In addition, the city is dotted with numerous parks where exotic plants flourish, including giant trees supposedly brought to Spain by Columbus from the New World.
