## What to Wear: Smart Attire.

We ask that you wear smart attire in most of our bars, restaurants, and entertainment venues. Smart trousers with a shirt and jacket for gentlemen; tie is optional. Ladies, blouses and skirts or stylish trousers and dresses are welcome. If you prefer to spend tonight in more relaxed attire, feel free to dress more casually in the following venues: Lido Buffet, Golden Lion Pub, Casino, Winter Garden and Yacht Club. Please note Non-ripped jeans are appropriate, but please refrain from wearing shorts, sports attire, swim wear or sleeveless t-shirts outside of the gym, spa and deck spaces.

## Spanish IVA (VAT).

Spanish IVA (VAT) at a rate of 10% is payable on all bar charges, select dining cover charges and room service charges whilst our ships are located within 12 nautical miles in Spanish territorial waters (i.e. during the times when we are entering and exiting Spanish ports as well as the time we are alongside in Spanish ports). Prices displayed in our bars, restaurants and room service menus are exclusive of this tax, therefore an additional 10% will be added to all bar charges, select dining cover charges and room service charges whilst our ships are in Spanish territorial waters. The Spanish IVA (VAT) element will be itemised separately on your receipt.

## Guest identification cards.

Please be aware that your Guest ID card (ship's identification card) is magnetised. These cards can easily become demagnetised if they are held next to another magnet, for example a credit card, magnets on a handbag, mobile phones, cameras, or if two identification cards are held next to one another. If you require any assistance visit the Purser's Office on deck 1 in the Grand Lobby.

## Hand antibacterial units on the gangway.

We encourage all guests to assist us in maintaining a healthy ship by using the hand antibacterial units that are located at the gangway.

## Safety and security ashore.

Whilst we do not wish to restrict your movements ashore today, we do suggest taking the following precautions:

- Do not stray from the main tourist areas.
- Do not wear any jewellery that is likely to attract attention.
- Be careful to secure personal possessions in pockets, wallets and handbags as pickpockets can operate in all cities.
- We advise you to be careful if you are taking any high value items, including cameras ashore.
- Maintain an awareness of your surroundings at all times.

In the unlikely event of you becoming a victim of a crime ashore please ask to see the Security Officer on your return to the ship.

## White star luggage service.

You are able to make arrangements to have the "White Star Luggage Service" transport your luggage home from Queen Victoria, from your disembarkation port of Southampton. The service takes approximately 5 to 7 working days. This service is provided through DHL Worldwide shipment service. If you are disembarking in Southampton on Friday, 16 November and you would like to enquire about this service, visit our White Star Luggage Coordinator on deck 1 in the Grand Lobby. Leave your details at the Purser's Office and the White Star Luggage Coordinator will contact you with a quote. The deadline to register for this service is Monday, 12 November at 12.00pm (noon).

# Daily Programme.

## We shall remember them.

When Queen Victoria conferred a baronetcy on Samuel Cunard it was in recognition of his company's significant contribution to the war effort in Crimea. Cunard's 14 ships carried 100,000 troops and 7,500 horses - including all those that charged with the Light Brigade. And Cunard ships saved hundreds of lives by transporting the wounded from Balaclava to Florence Nightingale's hospital in Scutari. A nation was grateful.

Since that first involvement, Cunard has come to the aid of the country in every conflict up to the Gulf War in 1990.

Possibly Cunard's most significant contribution as far as Britain was concerned was in the Second World War when Queen Mary and Queen Elizabeth ferried American GIs, whole divisions at a time, across the Atlantic to Europe. Of the ships Churchill said, "Without their aid the day of final victory must unquestionably have been postponed. To those who brought these two great ships into existence the world owes a debt that will not be easy to repay."

But undoubtedly the most poignant contribution for Cunard was in the First World War, when the company lost 20 of its 26 ships - over half its tonnage - and hundreds of its officers and crew. For the first time, U Boats ensured that merchant seamen were as much in the front line as soldiers in the trenches.

On this day, we will remember them. All of them.



## Remembrance Sunday Service with Captain Simon Love.



Today, will be marked as the 100th anniversary of the signing of the armistice ending World War I - the war to end all wars, as it was proclaimed at the time. The day is commemorated as Veterans Day in the United States, as Remembrance Day in the Commonwealth Nations and as Armistice Day in France and Belgium. On this day, we also should remember the sacrifices of our military personnel, as well as those of the merchant navy who deliver vital supplies across dangerous seas in times of war.

Thanks to its strategic position on the Mediterranean coastline, Cartagena has been inhabited by many different cultures, all of which have left their mark on its rich cultural heritage. Although some of the ruins are from the Carthaginian ages, like the Punic Ramparts built in 227 BC, most of the oldest monuments are Roman. The most notable Roman building is the recently restored Roman theatre of Carhago Nova, now a prominent landmark for the city. Cartagena is also home to numerous Art Nouveau buildings from the early 20th Century, built when the Bourgeoisie settled in the city. The main examples of this style of architecture are the City Hall, The Grand Hotel and the Casino.

Guests do not need to carry passports ashore today in the port of Cartagena, Spain, your Queen Victoria guest identification card is sufficient.
