Guest identification cards.

These cards can easily become demagnetised if they are held next to another magnet, for example a credit card, magnets on a handbag, mobile phones, cameras, or if two identification cards are held next to one another. If you require any assistance visit the Purser's Office on deck 1 in the Grand Lobby.

Hand antibacterial units on the gangway.

Health advice.

The deadline for sending mail is 2 hours before sailing when the ship is docked, and 3 hours prior if the ship is anchored and using tenders.




