## What to Wear: Smart Attire.

## Guest identification cards.

## Hand antibacterial units on the gangway.

## Security and safety ashore (pickpockets).

Whilst we do not wish to restrict your movements ashore today and in our upcoming ports, we do suggest taking the following precautions:

We then proceeded to enter the Rio Teje river, lining up on the leading lights for our approach into Lisbon. Passing under the 'Ponte 25 de Abril' one of the largest suspension bridges in the world, with a total length of 2,277m. This bridge has a nickname of 'The Buzzing Bridge' due to the noise the cars make when driving over the steel gratings that form the deck or road surface of the bridge.

Lisbon, the capital city of Portugal, has become an increasingly popular place to visit in recent years, with a warm Mediterranean climate in spite of its place facing the Atlantic Ocean. Lisbon is one of the oldest cities in the world and the oldest in Western Europe. Full of bleached white limestone buildings and intimate alleyways, Lisbon's mix of traditional architecture and contemporary culture makes it the perfect place for a holiday. There is a lot to see and do in Lisbon. Exploring the city centre will take a few days out of your holiday as there is no real central district, although Praça do Comércio is a good central place to start, in Baxia, or Rossio, the city's main square which has a sort of Trafalgar Square feel to it. Or you might try climbing up the Cristo Rei, a huge statue of Christ with spectacular views across the whole city. The Castelo de São Jorge also offers great views and isn't quite such a steep climb. A short tram ride to the west of Lisbon will also bring you to Belem, where you can explore attractions like the Belem Tower and the Belem Cultural Centre, which features a fantastic art collection including works by Dali, Picasso, Warhol and Magritte. In down town Lisbon, you'll also want to visit the Gulbenkian, which has to be Portugal's answer to the British Museum full of fascinating cultural artefacts and with some superb gardens in the grounds. It's possible to have a fascinating educational holiday in Lisbon, and there are also plenty of great beaches to work on your tan.

## Shuttle bus service.

There will be a continuous shuttle bus transfer service from Queen Victoria to Praca Dos Restauradores. The first bus will depart at 8.30am. The shuttle bus transfer will take approximately 20 minutes each way and is subject to local traffic conditions on the day. There will be an adapted bus that will run throughout the day. The last shuttle bus to return to Queen Victoria will be at 4.45pm. We will not be able to accommodate everybody on the last bus, so we ask that you plan your day accordingly. There is no need to purchase tickets in advance as we will scan your Guest ID card when boarding. A maximum of two journeys will be charged today; each additional journey will be free of charge. This service is chargeable for guests who booked Cunard Early Saver and Saver Fares. Adult Single \$6.00 per person (one way) and \$3.00 per child (one way). Guests who booked other fare types will not be charged for this shuttle bus transfer service. We anticipate long queues for the first hour, so you may wish to consider using a local taxi to avoid waiting.
