

Dominica (pronounced "Dom-ineek-a") is an island of volcanic origins located between the French islands of Guadeloupe and Martinique in the Eastern Caribbean. It is the largest and most mountainous of the the Windward Islands, at 29 miles long and 16 miles at its widest. The formal name Commonwealth of Dominica is often used to distinguish it from the Dominican Republic. There are a number of national parks or reserves on the island. The World Heritage Site and 17,000 acre Morne Trois Pitons National Park contains perhaps the majority of Dominica's above-water famous sights - several crater lakes and waterfalls, including the Emerald Pool, 14 miles from Roseau. Dominica's population is around 70,000 of which about 14,500 live in the capital city, Roseau (pronounced 'Ro-zo'). Roseau was named after the French name for the reeds that grow by the river (there is a Roseau in Minnesota named for the same reason). The original Carib name for Dominica is Waitikubuli, and many of the villages still retain (or at least know) their Carib name.

Karl had originally planned to join the Royal Navy, but chose the Merchant Navy instead and began a cadetship in early 2000 with a small coastal tanker firm, James Fisher. After completing the three year cadetship and working his way from 3rd to 2nd Officer, Karl felt like something was missing and began looking elsewhere. Recalling the story of the Carpathia, he looked into passenger ship companies. In the interim, he worked as a Navigator for the Royal Maritime Auxiliary Service, a former government agency charged with the maintenance of the navigational marks around the UK coastline. An offer came from Carnival UK in 2003 and Karl joined his first cruise ship, the Adonia, which took him on a World Voyage and firmly secured his love of passenger ships. For the next year and a half, he worked on P&O ships Oceana and Aurora as 3rd Officer before returning to college to study for his Chief Mates license. Afterwards, Karl was transferred to P&O Australia and decided to move to Australia for a short spell too. After a brief stint on Princess Cruises, it was time to return to college to study for his Masters ticket, which he gained in 2008. This led to brief contracts on board Arcadia and Ocean Village and finally his first Cunard ship, Queen Victoria. In 2009, he was promoted to 1st Officer and Navigator of Queen Mary 2, a position that fulfilled a lifelong dream. Queen Mary 2 is near to Karl's heart, as he met his wife, Jennie (a Purser), on board. Karl and Jennie transferred to Queen Elizabeth in 2011. Karl returned to Queen Mary 2 briefly as Chief Officer before moving to Oriana for 3 years as Safety Officer (formerly Chief Officer). In 2015, Karl was promoted to Deputy Captain on board Oriana prior to returning to Queen Mary 2. Karl lives with his wife and toddler son, Nicholas (who loves to travel on ships), in North Carolina in the United States. When not working, Karl enjoys running, carpentry and DIY projects, as well as rugby, basketball, and tennis, but most of all spending time with his family.
