From the Navigator.

After departure from St Kitts this evening Queen Mary 2 will disembark her local pilot, head west back into the Caribbean Sea and pass to the East of Saba Bank. The bank is a flat-topped seamount where depths are as little as 20 meters. It is crowned by a ring of growing coral and designated as a Particularly Sensitive Sea Area due to its rich biodiversity.

Intoxicating natural beauty, warm waters, and white sandy beaches combine to make St. Kitts one of the most seductive spots in the Caribbean. Christopher Columbus first spotted St. Kitts in 1493, when it was populated with native tribes, but the Europeans didn't colonize until the British arrived in 1623. Its strategic location and valuable sugar trade led to an advanced and luxurious development that was among the best in the Colonial Caribbean. While development has been of the highest quality, it has fortunately remained in low quantity, so St. Kitts remains un-crowded and unspoiled, famous around the world for excellent preservation of the ecosystems. Nature lovers will want to take advantage of the various tours through lava formations, tropical forest areas, and seaside lagoons. Boating tours and scuba diving expeditions are also favourites activities. Plantation homes have been transformed into grand, intimate inns. Quaint shopping areas and beautiful Colonial architecture draw visitors to the tiny towns.

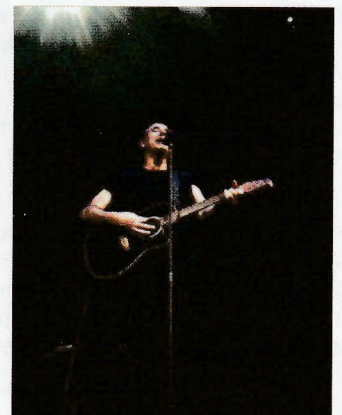

What to Wear: Smart Attire.

We ask that you wear smart attire in most of our bars, restaurants, and entertainment venues. Smart trousers with a shirt and jacket for gentlemen; tie is optional. Ladies, blouses and skirts or stylish trousers and dresses are welcome. If you prefer to spend tonight in more relaxed attire, feel free to dress more casually in the following venues: Kings Court, Golden Lion, Casino, Carinthia Lounge and G32. Please note non-ripped jeans are appropriate, but please refrain from wearing shorts, sports attire, swim wear or sleeveless t-shirts outside of the gym, spa and deck spaces.

Alcohol Policy.

Guests under 18 years of age (21 in US ports and territorial waters) will not be served alcoholic beverages nor are they to consume them on board. Please be aware that proof of age by means of government issued photographic identification, may be requested. Guests under the age of 18 are not permitted in G32.

Passport Information.

Local authorities require that ALL guests, regardless of nationality, MUST carry government issues photographic identification when going ashore in St Kitts.

Smoking policy.

For the safety, comfort and enjoyment of our guests, smoking (including Electronic alternatives) is not permitted in staterooms, on stateroom balconies or in public rooms. You will find designated areas on the open deck, deck 7 aft and deck 8 aft, port side immediately outside the entrance onto the deck only for smoking. Smokers should not drift beyond this point. The only exception to this is Churchill's Cigar Lounge, which is reserved for cigar and pipe smokers only. This policy is designed through direct feedback from our guests and is for the safety and comfort of all guests.

Your Security And Safety Ashore.

Whilst we do not wish to restrict your movements ashore today and in our upcoming ports, we do suggest taking the following precautions:

- Do not stray from the main tourist areas.
- Do not wear any jewellery that is likely to attract attention.
- Be careful to secure personal possessions in pockets, wallets and handbags as pickpockets can operate in all cities.
- We advise you to be careful if you are taking any high value items, including cameras ashore.
- Maintain an awareness of your surroundings at all times.

Deck chairs.

Deck chairs operate on a first-come, first served basis and cannot be reserved. For the consideration of all guests, please ensure you take your belongings when leaving a deck chair for a period of time, or they will be removed and taken to the Purser's Office for collection.

Jogging on Deck 7.

Please be advised that jogging and power walking on Deck 7 is not permitted before 8.00am or after 8.00pm as this disturbs guests sleeping below. Thank you for your co-operation.
