### From the Navigator.

During the early hours of this morning, Queen Mary 2 continued on her Great Circle track towards the Grand Banks of Newfoundland. Our track today will take us over



some of the deepest sections of the Atlantic itself with soundings in this area of more than 4500 metres or 2.5 miles. Queen Mary 2 will also pass the Flemish Cap later on this evening, a shallow of about 102 metres in the otherwise 3,500 metre deep ocean floor.

Southampton Centenary
Celebration



Cunard's move to Southampton was a definite boon for the region, bringing with it increased commerce and trade thanks to Cunard's mails and cargo service.

It was also a boon for passengers — with simple connections between Southampton and London allowing for quick transfers for business travellers and tourists alike.

Southampton's proximity to the continent meant calls in French ports were easier – allowing the line to collect European immigrants eager to start a new life in America.

By the 1950s Cunard's superliners – Queen Mary and Queen Elizabeth – were the largest vessels in the world. Based in Southampton the two Queens established the first two-ship weekly transatlantic express service linking Britain and North America in a way never before conceived.

Take a step back in time and enjoy a nostalgic journey aboard the one and only QE2 – Southampton's Queen! From the conception of "Number 736" to QE2's retirement in 2008; this lecture showcases the life and times of the longest serving transatlantic express liner in history – and the first Queen to carry the name Southampton around the world. We look at QE2's launch by HM. Queen Elizabeth II over fifty years ago and the ship's service in the Falklands War – commencing and culminating in Southampton. We explore her re-engining in the 1980s and rebirth in the 1990s. QE2 carried 2.5 million people and steamed 5.6 million miles; more than any ship – ever!

ESTA- Entering the USA on the Visa Waiver Programme.

Passport holders of the following nationalities must hold a Biometric Passport and ESTA (Electronic System for Travel Authorisation) which is required by United States Customs and Border Patrol for those guests wishing to enter the United States under the Visa Waiver Programme: Andorra, Australia, Austria, Belgium, Brunei, Chile, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Japan, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxemburg, Malta, Monaco, The Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Portugal, Sar Marino, Singapore, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, and the United Kingdom.

You can apply for an ESTA by going online to https://esta.cbp.dhs.gov; there is a charge of \$14 for processing and authorisation (plus standard internet charges apply when using the ship's internet facilities). When you have received confirmation, simply print the confirmation page and place it with your passport. Should you require any assistance, please use the Internet Centre between 3.30pm to 5.00pm or 7.00pm

If you are a passport holder of the above nationalities and in possession of a valid US visa, you are not required to be in possession of an ESTA.

Failure to be in possession of a valid ESTA when attending the US immigration inspection upon arrival to New York, can result in the individual being fined \$4300 for violating this requirement by United States Customs and Border Patrol.

What to Wear: Gala Evening. It's Showtime. Tonight we invite you to dress to impress and celebrate with us at one of our much anticipated Gala Evenings. Alcohol Policy

Guests under 18 years of age (21 in US ports and territorial waters) will not be served alcoholic beverages nor are they to consume them on board. Please be aware that proof of age by means of government issued photographic identification, may be requested. Guests under the age of 18 are not permitted in G32.

Luggage Storage in New York.

Guests who wish to store their luggage prior to their return voyage in the future may do so with 'Luggage Concierge' in New York. Please register at the Purser's Office. The deadline to sign up is 6.00pm today on Friday, 22 November. The cost of this service is \$195 per bag for up to 30 days and an additional \$30 per bag for the next 30 days. This will be charged to your on board account. Bags must be collected in the terminal ashore from the baggage hall and dropped off with the Luggage Concierge Representative after exiting customs.
