

J.S. immigration and Customs Formalities

On the morning of our arrival at Brooklyn Cruise Terminal, US Customs and Border Protection will be inspecting all Queen Mary 2 guests regardless of nationality (this includes our disembarking guests and those who are continuing their voyage with us). The inspection will be carried out in the terminal building. Guests are kindly requested to follow the disembarkation instructions that will be delivered to your stateroom.

Disembarking Guests:

After you have disembarked Queen Mary 2, please collect your luggage from the baggage hall and then proceed through the Immigration Inspection and clear Customs.

Guests who are continuing their voyage with us:

All guests continuing their voyage with us are required to attend the Immigration and Customs Inspection. Please be advised that you will not be allowed to return to the ship until all guests have disembarked. However, if you are not intending to go ashore for the day, please proceed to the Terminal when the final announcement is made, which is expected to be at 10.30am. Once you have cleared the inspection, you may proceed to the Embarkation Hall where there is seating available. You will be advised when you are allowed to reboard Queen Mary 2. There is no need to check-in again.

You are required to present the following at the inspection: PASSPORT: All guests regardless of nationality are required to present a passport to the Immigration Officials. Please keep your passport open on the information photo page.

IMMIGRATION FORMS: If you are a US citizen, a Green Card/ARC

Card holder, a Canadian Citizen or a passport holder of one of the nationalities listed under the Visa Waiver Programme and you are in possession of an ESTA no immigration forms are required. If the above does not apply to you then you must complete I-94 (White) form.
