

Road Town, located on Tortola Island, is the capital of the British Virgin Islands. It is situated on the horseshoe-shaped Road Harbour in the centre of the island's south coast. English is universally spoken throughout the British Virgin Islands. Those who work with tourists will speak quite clearly, but older natives have a thick and distinctive West Indian accent that, when spoken quickly, can be very difficult to understand. Because of the influence of British culture, a stronger emphasis is placed on politeness and decorum. From the eastern end of Tortola, Beef Island, to the west end, there are many spectacular white-sand beaches along the north shore. Some attractions that are available on the island are: Sage Mountain Park with lots of hiking; The British Virgin Islands' tallest mountain, Sage Mountain with a 360° view from the top of the mountain to outlying islands; the Callwood Rum Distillery, a historic Rum manufacturer; Fort Recovery, built in 1648 by a Dutch colonist; and the beautiful Joseph Reynold O'Neal Botanic Gardens with a great exhibition of the islands' vegetation.

Officer Profile: Captain Christopher Wells.

Captain Christopher Wells was born in Bournemouth and grew up in Poole, where his association with the sea was developed, sailing and fishing in Poole Harbour. He was educated at Poole Grammar School, completing A Levels before starting his sea-going career. In 1974 he began a four



year cadetship with Shell Tankers, attending the Warsash School of Navigation at the University of Southampton. His early days at sea were mostly spent in the Far East, trading out of Singapore on a variety of tankers. He continued his career with Shell, gaining his Master's Certificate in 1985 and progressing to Chief Officer, serving on a variety of ship types, including VLCCs (very large crude carriers), bulk carriers and gas carriers. He combined this with a commission in the Royal Naval Reserve, serving two weeks annually for 25 years with Maritime Forces in the Amphibious Warfare specialisation. On reaching mandatory retirement age from the RNR in 2011, Captain Wells was very pleased to be appointed Honorary Commander RNR by Her Majesty the Queen. In 1992 Captain Wells joined Cunard Line when a vacancy became available for a Second Officer on board Queen Elizabeth 2. He was promoted through the ranks, serving as Chief Officer on QE2, as well as Cunard Countess and Royal Viking Sun, before being promoted to Staff Captain on board QE2 in 1999. Captain Wells met his wife Hedda on board QE2. They were married in 1997 in her hometown of Husum in the North of Germany and now live in Barnham, near Chichester, in West Sussex. They have three children; Henry, Emily and William. In April 2002 Captain Wells was appointed to the site team at the shipyard of Chantiers de l'Atlantique at Saint Nazaire, France to represent Cunard Line during the construction of Queen Mary 2. He was the first Staff Captain of the new ship when she was handed over to Cunard on 22 December 2003, remaining with her until May 2005. Following the merger of P&O Princess with Cunard's parent company Carnival, Captain Wells was then appointed to Caribbean Princess as Staff Captain. In April 2006 Captain Wells was promoted to command P&O's Oriana and he has subsequently also commanded Oceana and P&O Australia's Pacific Dawn. He was then honoured and delighted to return to Cunard Line to command Queen Victoria, Queen Elizabeth and now Queen Mary 2.

Guests under 18 years of age (21 in US ports and territorial waters) will not be served alcoholic beverages nor are they to consume them on board. Please be aware that proof of age by means of government issued photographic identification, may be requested. Guests under the age of 18 are not permitted in G32.

Your Security And Safety Ashore.

Whilst we do not wish to restrict your movements ashore today and in our upcoming ports, we do suggest taking the following precautions:

- Do not stray from the main tourist areas.
- Do not wear any jewellery that is likely to attract attention.
- Be careful to secure personal possessions in pockets, wallets and handbags as pickpockets can operate in all cities.
- We advise you to be careful if you are taking any high value items, including cameras ashore.
- Maintain an awareness of your surroundings at all times.

Important: Notice For All Caribbean Ports.

We wish to caution guests when ashore, that drugs are available and frequently offered for sale. Please do not be coerced into purchasing these substances as in most cases you will be caught. Cunard has a zero tolerance policy with regard to the unlawful possession of drugs and any guest violating this policy will be immediately disembarked from the vessel. Local law enforcement agencies have become especially vigilant in their efforts to eradicate both drug abuse and trafficking and these have included subjecting guests to a physical search on return to the ship. Should a guest be disembarked for illegally possessing drugs, Cunard is unable to offer any assistance in dealing with the local authorities or making homeward travel arrangements.
