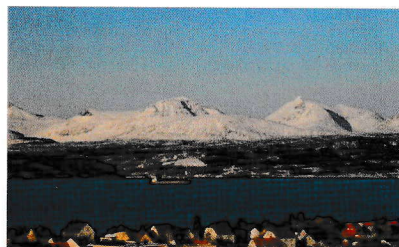

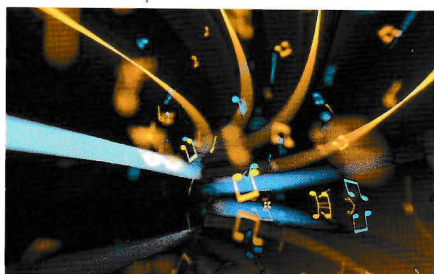

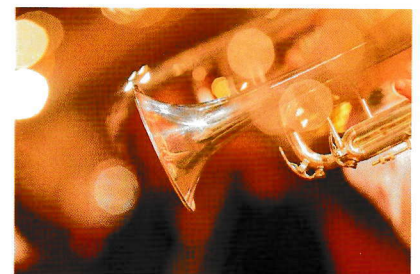

Smoking Policy.

In response to customer feedback we have recently updated our smoking policy. All public spaces are designated as non smoking areas within the ship, with the exception of our designated smoking areas, on the starboard side of Decks 3 and 10. Please be aware smoking is not permitted in the area/walkway above the canvas canopy linking the port and starboard side. Smoking is not permitted in your stateroom/suite or on your balcony. Electronic cigarettes and vaporising devices, including those which do not emit smoke/vapour, are permitted in designated smoking areas only. Alcohol Policy.

Guests under 18 years of age are not permitted to purchase or consume alcohol on board. Please be aware that proof of age by means of government issued photographic identification, may be requested. Guests under the age of 18 years are also not permitted in the Yacht Club after 11.00pm.

EVAC Notice.

We remind all our guests that our EVAC system (toilet evacuation system on board) is not able to process wet wipes. Therefore we kindly ask all our guests to dispose wet wipes using sanitary bags, which can be found below the sink in each stateroom, in the designated toilets bin. Thanks for your understanding and cooperation.

Noise in Guest areas.

We kindly ask all guests to be respectful to fellow travelling companions as regards keeping noise to a minimum. Please be aware not to slam doors either into corridors or onto balconies and be mindful when using laundrette facilities as guests around you may be resting.
