## Port Highlights



This morning at 7.00am Queen Victoria will pick up her local harbour pilot and begin her 5 mile inbound passage to the berth here in Heraklion, on the island of Crete. After an enjoyable day in port, later this evening Queen Victoria will depart for Piraeus via the Heraklion Gulf, proceeding into the Aegean Sea on a north-westerly course. Overnight, we will pass the islands of Milos and Antimilos at a range of 4 nautical miles off our starboard side, before making our approaches in towards Piraeus tomorrow morning.

Heraklion, also known as Iraklio, is a port city and the capital of the Greek island of Crete. It's known for the Palace of Knossos, just outside the city. The huge archaeological site dates back thousands of years to the Minoan civilization, and includes frescoes and baths. Guarding the city's Venetian port is the 16th-century Koules fortress. Heraklion Archaeological Museum has a large collection of Minoan art.

**Currency:** The currency used in Heraklion is the Euro (€) which is available on board. Currency exchange of Euros (€) and US dollars (US\$) is available from the Purser's Office on Deck 1 in the Grand Lobby. Please be advised we can only accept the denominations that we sell.

**Postage:** Postcards and letters weighing less than 50g in weight can be posted via the Purser's Desk on Deck 1 in the Grand Lobby. There is a charge of US\$3.00 for this service. All postage must be in by 3.00pm.

**Ship's Security Notice:** In order to prevent unauthorised persons boarding the ship, you are required to carry your voyage identification card with you when going ashore. You will be asked to produce this at the gangway when you leave and return to the ship. Be aware that we have established a secure area around the vessel and our security procedures require that you must be prepared to show your voyage identification card when entering this area, in addition to showing it to the Security Staff at the gangway when leaving or boarding the ship. We kindly ask you not to accept and bring on board any parcels or packages from strangers. Before boarding the ship, you may also be asked by our Security Staff to open parcels or handbags which you are carrying. We are sure that you will appreciate that this security is in the best interest of all concerned.

**Safety and Security Ashore:** Whilst we do not wish to restrict your movements ashore we do suggest taking the following precautions:

- Do not stray from the main tourist areas.
- Do not wear any jewellery that is likely to attract attention.
- Be careful to secure personal possessions in pockets, wallets and handbags as pickpockets can operate in all cities.
- We advise you to be careful if you are taking any high value items, including cameras ashore.
- Maintain an awareness of your surroundings at all times.

Please note it may be necessary to walk some distance to reach your mode of transport for your designated shore experience. Please understand that there may be queues at peak periods of travel and seating is on a first-come, first-served basis. We may not be able to accommodate everybody on the last tender, so we ask that you plan your day accordingly.

### Shuttle Bus Service Notice

Due to the Taxi Association, shuttle buses are not permitted to transport passengers from the ship into town. Shuttle buses operate from the ship to the main terminal building and it takes approximately 15-20 minutes to walk from the main terminal building to town. Taxis cost, approximately 5 euros each way.

### Wheelchair Assistance

Guests are kindly reminded that wheelchair assistance, if required, will be provided to assist guests on and off the gangway only. As per the terms and conditions stated in the Cunard brochure, guests must be able to make their own way to the transportation on the pier or be accompanied by a travel companion who is able to assist them.

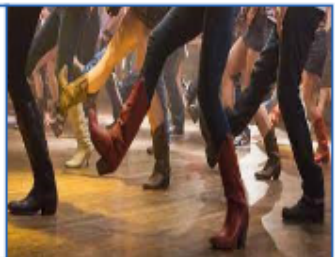
