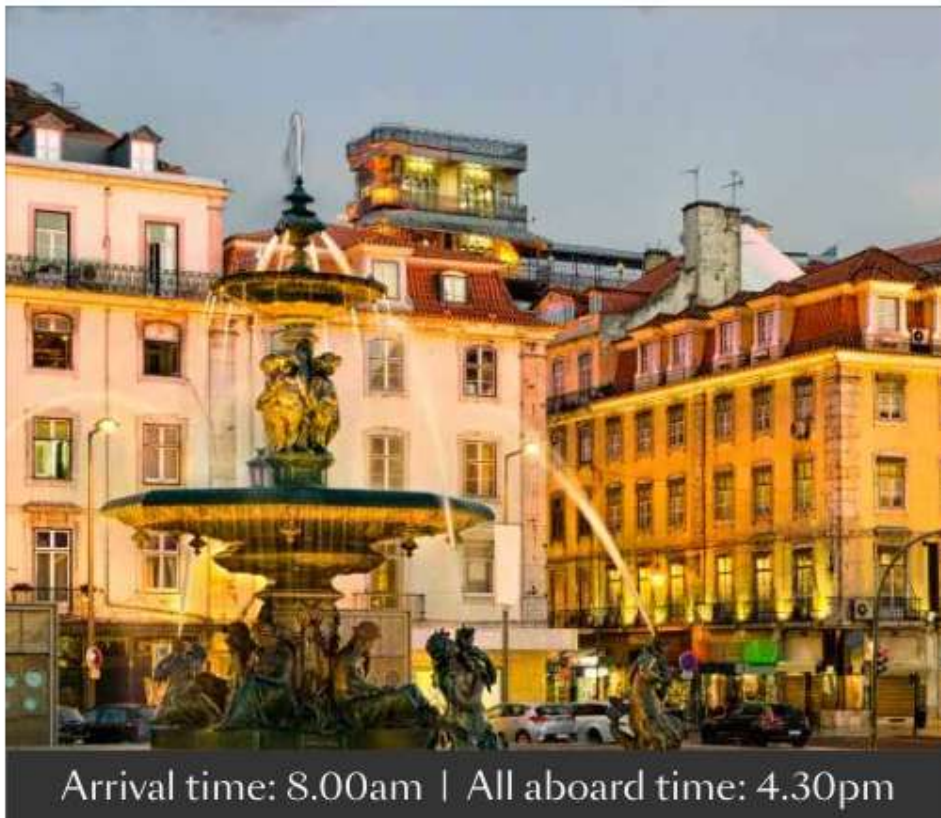

Port Highlights



Lisbon is the capital city and largest city of Portugal. It is the westernmost large city located in Europe, as well as its westernmost capital city and the only one along the Atlantic coast. Lisbon is one of the oldest cities in the world, predating other modern European capitals such as London, Paris and Rome by hundreds of years. Julius Caesar made it a municipium called Felicitas Julia, adding to the name Olissipo. Ruled by a series of Germanic tribes from the fifth century, it was captured by the Moors in the eighth century. In 1147, the Crusaders under Afonso Henriques reconquered the city and since then it has been a major political, economic, and cultural centre of Portugal. A traditional form of public transport in Lisbon is the tram. Introduced in the 19th century, the trams were originally imported from the USA. Other than on the modern Line 15, the Lisbon tramway system still employs small (four wheel) vehicles of a design dating from the early part of the twentieth century. These distinctive yellow trams are one of the tourist icons of modern Lisbon, and their size is well suited to the steep hills and narrow streets of the central city.

We kindly ask you not to attend any earlier than the advertised time as the transportation won't be ready and there will be no available seating. All shore experience transportation will have your shore experience stated in the front window. Please note it is necessary to walk some distance to reach your mode of transport for your designated shore experience.

We are pleased to advise that we do offer water for purchase in Carinthia Lounge on Deck 3, Midship to take on your designated shore experience.

Complimentary Shuttle Service

A complimentary shuttle bus service will be in operation between Queen Anne and drop off point Restauradores Square (outside Mango the clothes shop). The first shuttle bus will depart at 8.15am from the ship and the transfer time is approximately 30 minutes each way which is subject to local traffic conditions on the day. The last shuttle bus from drop off/pick up point to Queen Anne will be at 3.45pm. There will be a limited wheelchair accessible shuttle service operating throughout the day. Please understand that there may be queues at peak periods of travel and seating is on a first come, first-served basis. Please note that we will not be able to accommodate everybody on the last bus, so we ask that you plan your day accordingly. For guests that wish to walk, it is a flat, easy walk along the sea front of roughly 20 minutes to Praco do Comercio and approximately 30 minutes to Restauradores.

Ship's Security Notice

In order to prevent unauthorised persons boarding the ship, you are required to carry your guest identification card with you when going ashore.

You will be asked to produce this at the gangway when you leave and return to the ship. Be aware that we have established a secure area around the vessel and our security procedures require that you must be prepared to show your guest identification card when entering this area, in addition to showing it to the Security Staff at the gangway when leaving or boarding the ship.

We kindly ask you not to accept and bring on board any parcels or packages from strangers. Before boarding the ship, you may also be asked by our Security Staff to open parcels or handbags which you are carrying. We are sure that you will appreciate that this security is in the best interest of all concerned.

Currency: Legal tender in Lisbon is the Euro (EUR). Foreign exchange is available from the Purser's Office on Deck 1, Grand Lobby. Queen Anne deals in US Dollars.

Postage: Postcards and letters can be posted via the Purser's Office. The postage cost in Lisbon is \$3.00 per postcard/letter. If you already have a stamp on your letter or postcard we can still post it for you at the Purser's Office. This facility will close at 2.00pm and any post received after this time will only be posted in the following port.

The Pavilion

European Tax Refund

During our ports of call, qualifying purchases may have been made in certain shops which offer the opportunity to claim a refund of the EU tax. Guests are able to claim this refund today in Lisbon. This service will be available from 1.00pm to 4.00pm in the terminal building. We regret we cannot handle any refund enquiries or requests after sailing from Lisbon.

Fast Track Disembarkation - Southampton

Be first to disembark Queen Anne and onto your journey home with Fast Track disembarkation. This service allows guests who can carry all their luggage themselves to disembark from 6.45am to 7.30am upon arrival in Southampton, ahead of the general disembarkation process. Book fast track disembarkation in advance through the Purser's Office to secure your spot and enjoy a smoother start to your onward journey.

Ship's Security and Safety Notice in Lisbon

Whilst many thousands of tourists visit Lisbon each year without incident, we would like to remind you about the ongoing threat caused by pickpockets.

There are a few simple things that will reduce the chances of you becoming a victim of crime.

- Please do not carry high value items.
- Always zip / close your bags.
- Do not take all your bank or credit cards with you.
- Keep a close eye on any bag (backpack / handbag) whilst eating in restaurants. Try and keep them within view.
- Avoid items which easily identify you as a tourist.
- Leave your passport on the ship.

Your safety and security are always our prime concern when you are on board the ship. Whilst the chances of you being affected by pickpockets is slim it is important for us that you are aware of this localised issue and remain vigilant.
