# From the Navigator



The seas between Gibraltar and Lisbon were the scenes of many naval battles. The seas surrounding Cádiz and Gibraltar staged the Batlle of Trafalgar, the pivotal naval war of the Napoleonic wars. Outnumbered by the combined French and Spanish Fleet, Admiral Nelson famously fell in battle, not living to see his masterminded success and place in naval history. As we head up the coast, the Portuguese city of Faro was occupied by the Moors in the eight century, famous for their navigational expertise, settled in the ancient city having sailed from the Southern Mediterranean. Many stars used in our navigation are named in Arabic as a consequence of their expertise in celestial movements and navigating by the stars. Faro was held for over 500 years by the Moors, who left an indelible mark on the architecture within the region.
