From the Navigator



Queen Anne will today pass through the traffic separation scheme at Ushant. The Ushant Traffic Vessel Tracking Service surveillance area where Queen Anne will be asked to declare her oil and fuel figures to the French officials. A deep sea tug is available at this rocky outcrop to aid ships in trouble, and knowing these figures can help the authorities to act quickly to prevent environmental disasters. These were lessons learned from the Erica disaster in 1999 which was Europe's largest spill and a reminder that our environment is certainly something we should take extremely seriously in shipping. Later we will be joining the busy traffic lanes of the English Channel, passing to the south of two prominent light houses, Start Point Light in Devon and Portland Bill in Dorset, before our pilot rendez-vous in the Eastern Solent.

Luggage collection

Fast Track Disembarkation - Southampton

Be first to disembark Queen Anne and onto your journey home with Fast Track disembarkation. This service allows guests who can carry all their luggage themselves to disembark from 6.45am to 7.30am upon arrival in Southampton, ahead of the general disembarkation process. Book fast track disembarkation in advance through the Purser's Office to secure your spot and enjoy a smoother start to your onward journey.

Cash payments

For guests disembarking in Southampton on 1 December, please note the deadline of 10.00pm, today for the following services:

- Making a cash payment. After this deadline, all charges will be settled to the registered credit card. Please be advised that no cash will be refunded to your credit card.
- Charging cash back and/or foreign exchange to your on board account. Cash for cash foreign exchange facilities/transactions are available until the time of disembarkation on 1 December. Please note that failure to settle your account will result in delays to your disembarkation.

Cash out reminder

A friendly reminder to all our guests to cash out all of your casino winnings, chips, and slot machine credits before the Casino on Deck 3 closes tonight as this will not transfer automatically to your on board account. This applies even if you are continuing onwards.

United Kingdom Customs allowance (Tax and duty free items)

Disembarking guests have a UK Customs allowance of 4 litres of spirits and liquors (over 22% volume) or 9 litres of sparkling wine/fortified wine/aperitifs, and additionally 18 litres of wine (not sparkling). You also have an allowance of 200 cigarettes or 50 cigars or 100 cigarillos or 250 grams of tobacco (for guests 17 years of age or older), and you are allowed gifts and souvenirs up to the value of £390.00. If you are in excess of the Customs allowance, you must visit the Red Point in the terminal building and declare all articles purchased abroad. If you are in doubt you should stop at the Red Point before entering the Green Channel on your way to the exit.
