From the Navigator



After letting go her lines last night, Queen Anne made her way out through Southampton water and into the Solent, where she disembarked her pilot and then continued out into the English Channel. Throughout the night Queen Anne followed a west-south-westerly course through the Channel, arriving today in the Bay of Biscay, where south-westerly courses were set towards the Spanish western coast. Queen Anne will cross the Bay of Biscay, which is notorious to yachtsmen and sailors. The depth of the Bay plays a significant role in its turbulent nature. At its deepest, the Bay of Biscay plunges to more than 15,000 feet. Deepwater currents, when met with shallower continental shelves, contribute to the Bay's infamous rough conditions. However, these currents make the Bay of Biscay rich with marine life and so, if you are out on deck today, keep a good look out for dolphins and whales.

Register a payment method

Please ensure that you have registered a payment method (cash or credit card) against your on board account. You can do so at the Purser's Office. If no payment method has been registered, your account will be automatically changed to 'protected status' and you will be unable to charge to your account.

Ship's security notice

In order to prevent unauthorised persons boarding the ship, you are required to carry your guest identification card with you when going ashore.

You will be asked to produce this at the gangway when you leave and return to the ship. Be aware that we have established a secure area around the vessel and our security procedures require that you must be prepared to show your guest identification card when entering this area, in addition to showing it to the Security Staff at the gangway when leaving or boarding the ship.

We kindly ask you not to accept and bring on board any parcels or packages from strangers. Before boarding the ship, you may also be asked by our Security Staff to open parcels or handbags which you are carrying. We are sure that you will appreciate that this security is in the best interest of all concerned.

Prohibited items on balconies

For safety reasons and to protect and preserve the marine environment, no towels or any other personal belongings are to be left on the balcony when the stateroom occupants are not present.

Bright Lights Society

Guests under 18 years of age are not permitted to enter the venue after 11.30pm. Please be aware that proof of age by means of government issued photographic identification, may be requested.

Smoking policy

For the safety, comfort and enjoyment of our guests, smoking (including electronic alternatives) is not permitted in staterooms, on stateroom balconies or in public rooms. You will find a designated smoking area on Deck 14, portside, forward of the Sky Bar, accessed via Stairway A. Smokers should not drift beyond this point. The only exception to this is Churchill's Cigar Lounge, which is reserved for cigar and pipe smokers only. This policy is designed through direct feedback from our guests and is for the safety and comfort of all guests.

Alcohol policy

Guests who are under 18 years of age are not permitted to purchase or consume alcohol on board. However, while in U.S. waters, Cunard enforces and abides by the U.S. legal drinking age of 21 years.
