From the Navigator



Today Queen Anne finds herself passing Cape Finisterre, which is always worthy of note for a navigator. It has been used as a navigational mark for millennia. It is a rock-bound peninsula on the west coast of Galicia. We will pass the cape at a distance of around 40 nautical miles today, as we make our way through the Finisterre Traffic Separation Scheme. The name Finisterre derives from the Latin finis terrae, meaning "end of the earth" as, during the Roman Era, this point was believed to be the end of the known world. Throughout the day southerly courses will be made, paralleling the Spanish and Portuguese coastlines, as we make our way towards Cádiz.


