Port Highlights



Historic, mysterious and romantic, the Spanish city of Cádiz is unlike any other. Founded in about 1100 BC, it is generally accepted as the oldest continuously inhabited settlement in today's Europe. But for the thin strip connecting it to the mainland to its south, Cádiz is an island of history and architecture that impresses at every turn through the streets of this charming ancient port. You will find a complex warren of streets, bustling bars and pretty beaches; it is difficult to know what to do or where to go first. Packed with historic sites, monuments and an excellent museum of art and archaeology, Cádiz is a draw for history buffs and those attracted by the arts. Consider a visit to the Catedral de Cádiz, an elegant, baroque-neoclassical, yellow-domed cathedral. Admire the view from the Campo del Sur as the sun goes down to see a breath-taking array of colours. Outside the cathedral, you will find the sizeable Casa del Obispo museum. It is on the site of 1,640 square yards of excavated ruins, and helps to bring to life the colourful history of Cádiz.

Ship's Security and Safety Notice in Cádiz

Whilst many thousands of tourists visit Cádiz each year without incident, we would like to remind you about the ongoing threat caused by pickpockets in the port and city centre.

There are a few simple things that will reduce the chances of you becoming a victim of crime.

- Please do not carry high value items.
- Always zip / close your bags.
- Do not take all your bank or credit cards with you.
- Keep a close eye on any bag (backpack / handbag) whilst eating in restaurants. Try and keep them within view.
- Avoid items which easily identify you as a tourist.
- Leave your passport on the ship.

Your safety and security are always our prime concern when you are on board the ship. Whilst the chances of you being affected by pickpockets is slim it is important for us that you are aware of this localised issue and remain vigilant.

Thank you for your attention to this matter and we hope you enjoy your time ashore.

Ship's Security Notice

In order to prevent unauthorised persons boarding the ship, you are required to carry your guest identification card with you when going ashore.

You will be asked to produce this at the gangway when you leave and return to the ship. Be aware that we have established a secure area around the vessel and our security procedures require that you must be prepared to show your guest identification card when entering this area, in addition to showing it to the Security Staff at the gangway when leaving or boarding the ship.

We kindly ask you not to accept and bring on board any parcels or packages from strangers. Before boarding the ship, you may also be asked by our Security Staff to open parcels or handbags which you are carrying. We are sure that you will appreciate that this security is in the best interest of all concerned.

Currency: Legal tender in Cádiz is the Euro (EUR). Foreign exchange is available from the Purser's Office on Deck 1, Grand Lobby. Queen Anne deals in US Dollars.

Postage: Postcards and letters can be posted via the Purser's Office. The postage cost in Cádiz is \$3.00 per postcard/letter. If you already have a stamp on your letter or postcard we can still post it for you at the Purser's Office. This facility will close at 2.00pm and any post received after this time will only be posted in the following port.

Spanish VAT (IVA)

Following changes in European VAT Regulations, Spanish IVA (VAT) at a rate of 10%, is applicable on all bar charges, select dining cover charges and room service charges whilst our ships are located in Spanish territorial waters, (i.e. during the times when we are entering and exiting Spanish ports as well as the time we are alongside in Spanish ports). Prices displayed in our bars, restaurants and room service menus are exclusive of this tax and therefore an additional 10% will be added to all bar charges, select dining cover charges and room service charges whilst our ships are in Spanish territorial waters. The Spanish IVA (VAT) element will be itemised separately on your receipt.

Crew emergency drill

At 10.00am this morning, alarms will be sounded and broadcasts made as the crew are exercised in their emergency duties. During this exercise, limited guest services will be provided. You are advised that part of the exercise involves checking guest staterooms to ensure that they have been evacuated. If you prefer not to be disturbed, please display the "Privacy Please" notice prior to the start of the drill. For the duration of the crew drill, we kindly request that guests please keep clear of the outside area of the boat deck.

Register a payment method

Please ensure that you have registered a payment method (cash or credit card) against your on board account. You can do so at the Purser's Office. If no payment method has been registered, your account will be automatically changed to 'protected status' and you will be unable to charge to your account.

Smoking Policy

For the safety, comfort and enjoyment of our guests, smoking (including electronic alternatives) is not permitted in staterooms, on stateroom balconies or in public rooms. You will find a designated smoking area on Deck 14, portside, forward of the Sky Bar, accessed via Stairway A. Smokers should not drift beyond this point. The only exception to this is Churchill's Cigar Lounge, which is reserved for cigar and pipe smokers only. This policy is designed through direct feedback from our guests and is for the safety and comfort of all guests.
