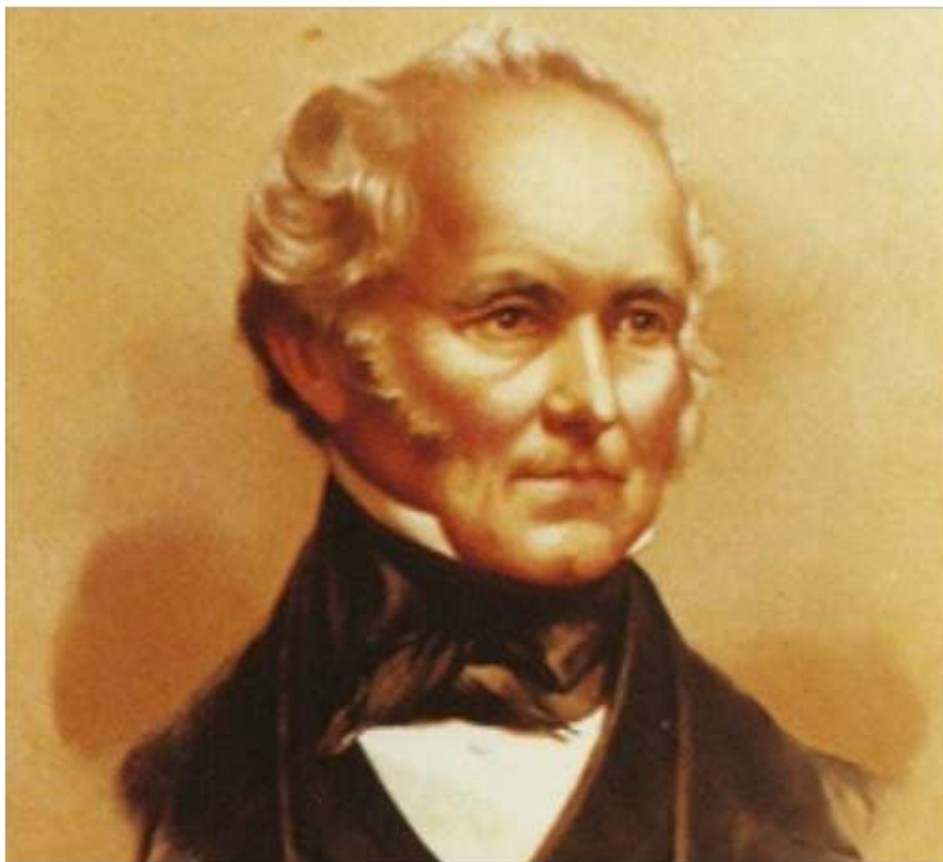

Today we mark the birthday of Sir Samuel Cunard. Born in Halifax, Nova Scotia, he was the founder of the Cunard Line and established the first scheduled service across the Atlantic. Happy birthday Sir Samuel!

From the Navigator



From our departure from Cádiz, Queen Anne made her way through the Gibraltar Straits. The Gibraltar Straits have often been regarded as some of the most important water ways in Europe guarding the entrance to the Mediterranean. The straits measure 8.1 miles in diameter at their narrowest point. Today we are transiting the north of the Alborán Sea, the westernmost part of the Mediterranean, a transition area between the basins which have radically different oceanographic characteristics. This transition area contains important habitat for endangered Mediterranean common dolphins and vulnerable common bottlenose dolphins. We will finally pass through the Cabo de Gata Traffic Separation Scheme before making our approaches to Cartagena.
