

Port Highlights



Situated in the Region of Murcia, on the Mediterranean coast of south-eastern Spain, Cartagena is a historical major naval port. Cartagena is also home to one of the world's greatest natural harbors. With a fascinating history dating back 3,000 years, Cartagena's landscape consists of varied architecture, including modernista-style buildings, flamboyant mosaics and ornate balconies that have become synonymous with the area. Cartagena is, without a doubt, a fantastic destination if you love nothing more than immersing yourself in history. Boasting 12 museums, four churches, countless historical monuments, and 10 buildings of interest, Cartagena is one of the best places to soak up the fascinating history of Spain. Top landmarks and sights include the Roman Theatre, built between the fifth and first centuries BC, the Palacio Consistorial, built between 1900 and 1907, Castillo de la Concepción, and The Naval Museum.

We kindly ask you not to attend any earlier than the advertised time as the transportation won't be ready and there will be no available seating. All shore experience transportation will have your shore experience stated in the front window. Please check before boarding your transportation or if unsure please ask a member of the shore experience team.

Please note it may be necessary to walk some distance to reach your mode of transport for your designated shore experience.

We are pleased to advise that we do offer water for purchase in Carinthia Lounge on Deck 3, Midship to take on your designated shore experience.

Ship's Security Notice

In order to prevent unauthorised persons boarding the ship, you are required to carry your guest identification card with you when going ashore.

You will be asked to produce this at the gangway when you leave and return to the ship. Be aware that we have established a secure area around the vessel and our security procedures require that you must be prepared to show your guest identification card when entering this area, in addition to showing it to the Security Staff at the gangway when leaving or boarding the ship.

We kindly ask you not to accept and bring on board any parcels or packages from strangers. Before boarding the ship, you may also be asked by our Security Staff to open parcels or handbags which you are carrying. We are sure that you will appreciate that this security is in the best interest of all concerned.

Alcohol Policy

Guests who are under 18 years of age are not permitted to purchase or consume alcohol on board. However, while in U.S. waters, Cunard enforces and abides by the U.S. legal drinking age of 21 years.

Prohibited items on balconies

For safety reasons and to protect and preserve the marine environment, no towels or any other personal belongings are to be left on the balcony when the stateroom occupants are not present.

Sun loungers and deck chairs

Sun loungers and deck chair operate on a first-come, first served basis and cannot be reserved. For the consideration of all guests, please ensure you take your belongings when leaving a deck chair for a period of time, or they will be removed and taken to the Purser's Office for collection.

Bright Lights Society

Guests under 18 years of age are not permitted to enter the venue after 11.30 pm. Please be aware that proof of age by means of government issued photographic identification, may be requested.



Currency: Legal tender in Cartagena is the Euro (EUR). Foreign exchange is available from the Purser's Office on Deck 1, Grand Lobby, Queen Anne deals in US Dollars.

Postage: Postcards and letters can be posted via the Purser's Office. The postage cost in Cartagena is \$3.00 per postcard/letter. If you already have a stamp on your letter or postcard we can still post it for you at the Purser's Office. This facility will close at 2.00pm and any post received after this time will only be posted in the following port.

Spanish VAT (IVA)

Following changes in European VAT Regulations, Spanish IVA (VAT) at a rate of 10%, is applicable on all bar charges, select dining cover charges and room service charges whilst our ships are located in Spanish territorial waters, (i.e. during the times when we are entering and exiting Spanish ports as well as the time we are alongside in Spanish ports). Prices displayed in our bars, restaurants and room service menus are exclusive of this tax and therefore an additional 10% will be added to all bar charges, select dining cover charges and room service charges whilst our ships are in Spanish territorial waters. The Spanish IVA (VAT) element will be itemised separately on your receipt.

Register a payment method

Please ensure that you have registered a payment method (cash or credit card) against your on board account. You can do so at the Purser's Office, If no payment method has been registered, your account will be automatically changed to 'protected status' and you will be unable to charge to your account.

Smoking Policy

For the safety, comfort and enjoyment of our guests, smoking (including electronic alternatives) is not permitted in staterooms, on stateroom balconies or in public rooms. You will find a designated smoking area on Deck 14, portside, forward of the Sky Bar, accessed via Stairway A. Smokers should not drift beyond this point. The only exception to this is Churchill's Cigar Lounge, which is reserved for cigar and pipe smokers only. This policy is designed through direct feedback from our guests and is for the safety and comfort of all guests.

Looking ahead to Valencia: Shuttle bus service information

We are pleased to offer a complimentary shuttle bus service between Queen Anne and Av. del Professor López Piñero, located next to the City of Arts and Sciences. Please note, this shuttle does not go directly to the Old Town. If you wish to visit the Old Town, you can either book a direct transfer through our Shore Experiences or take a taxi, which can be easily found at the terminal or near the shuttle drop-off point. For your reference, the distance between the City of Arts and Sciences and the Old Town is approximately 3 km, which takes around 40 minutes to walk, 25 minutes by public transport, or 15 minutes by taxi. We hope you enjoy your time in Valencia!
