We kindly ask you not to attend any earlier than the advertised time as the transportation won't be ready and there will be no available seating. All shore experience transportation will have your shore experience stated in the front window. Please check before boarding your transportation or if unsure please ask a member of the shore experience team.

Please note it may be necessary to walk some distance to reach your mode of transport for your designated shore experience.

We are pleased to advise that we do offer water for purchase in Carinthia Lounge on Deck 3, Midship to take on your designated shore experience.

### Shuttle bus service information

A complimentary shuttle bus service will be in operation between Queen Anne and Av. del Professor López Piñero, located next to the City of Arts and Sciences. The first shuttle bus will depart at 8.30am from the ship and the transfer time is approximately 15 minutes each way which is subject to local traffic conditions on the day. The last shuttle bus from drop off/pick up point to Queen Anne will be at 5.00pm. There will be a limited wheelchair accessible shuttle service operating throughout the day.

Please note, this shuttle does not go directly to the Old Town. If you wish to visit the Old Town, you can either take a taxi, which can be easily found at the terminal or near the shuttle drop-off point. For your reference, the distance between the City of Arts and Sciences and the Old Town is approximately 3 km, which takes around 40 minutes to walk, 25 minutes by public transport, or 15 minutes by taxi. You can also book a direct transfer through our Shore Experiences which will depart at 10.00am from the Pier.

There will also be a limited complimentary shuttle bus service in operation between Queen Anne and the port entrance (Transmed-Grimaldi). Port shuttles are not controlled by Cunard and the frequency of this bus is governed by the port authorities. The transfer time is approximately 5 minutes each way and is subject to local traffic conditions on the day.

Please understand that there may be queues at peak periods of travel and seating is on a first come, first-served basis. Please note that we will not be able to accommodate everybody on the last bus, so we ask that you plan your day accordingly.

### Ship's Security Notice

In order to prevent unauthorised persons boarding the ship, you are required to carry your guest identification card with you when going ashore.

You will be asked to produce this at the gangway when you leave and return to the ship. Be aware that we have established a secure area around the vessel and our security procedures require that you must be prepared to show your guest identification card when entering this area, in addition to showing it to the Security Staff at the gangway when leaving or boarding the ship.

We kindly ask you not to accept and bring on board any parcels or packages from strangers. Before boarding the ship, you may also be asked by our Security Staff to open parcels or handbags which you are carrying. We are sure that you will appreciate that this security is in the best interest of all concerned.

### Prohibited items on balconies

For safety reasons and to protect and preserve the marine environment, no towels or any other personal belongings are to be left on the balcony when the stateroom occupants are not present.

**Currency:** Legal tender in Valencia is the Euro (EUR). Foreign exchange is available from the Purser's Office on Deck 1, Grand Lobby. Queen Anne deals in US Dollars.

**Postage:** Postcards and letters can be posted via the Purser's Office. The postage cost in Valencia is \$3.00 per postcard/letter. If you already have a stamp on your letter or postcard we can still post it for you at the Purser's Office. This facility will close at 2.00pm and any post received after this time will only be posted in the following port.

### Spanish VAT (IVA)

Following changes in European VAT Regulations, Spanish IVA (VAT) at a rate of 10%, is applicable on all bar charges, select dining cover charges and room service charges whilst our ships are located in Spanish territorial waters, (i.e. during the times when we are entering and exiting Spanish ports as well as the time we are alongside in Spanish ports). Prices displayed in our bars, restaurants and room service menus are exclusive of this tax and therefore an additional 10% will be added to all bar charges, select dining cover charges and room service charges whilst our ships are in Spanish territorial waters. The Spanish IVA (VAT) element will be itemised separately on your receipt.

### Register a payment method

Please ensure that you have registered a payment method (cash or credit card) against your on board account. You can do so at the Purser's Office. If no payment method has been registered, your account will be automatically changed to 'protected status' and you will be unable to charge to your account.

### Smoking Policy

For the safety, comfort and enjoyment of our guests, smoking (including electronic alternatives) is not permitted in staterooms, on stateroom balconies or in public rooms. You will find a designated smoking area on Deck 14, portside, forward of the Sky Bar, accessed via Stairway A. Smokers should not drift beyond this point. The only exception to this is Churchill's Cigar Lounge, which is reserved for cigar and pipe smokers only. This policy is designed through direct feedback from our guests and is for the safety and comfort of all guests.

Guests under 18 years of age are not permitted to enter the venue after 11.30pm. Please be aware that proof of age by means of government issued photographic identification, may be requested.
