## Port Highlights



Located on the Costa del Sol which literally translates as Coast of the Sun, Málaga is the perfect way to immerse yourself in the culture of Southern Spain. Marvel at Moorish and Roman architecture. The city is extremely walkable, with an influx of green spaces and a promenade that's perfect for stretching your legs. Nearly all of Málaga's must-see sights, including the golden sands of its Malagueta Beach, are located close to the cruise terminal.

All shore experience transportation will have your shore experience stated in the front window. Please note it may be necessary to walk some distance to reach your mode of transport for your designated shore experience.

We are pleased to advise that we do offer water for purchase in Carinthia Lounge on Deck 3, Midship to take on your designated shore experience.

### Shuttle bus service information

A complimentary shuttle bus service will be in operation between Queen Anne and drop off point Main gate of the port, called Plaza de la Marina. The first shuttle bus will depart at 8.00am from the ship and the transfer time is approximately 15 minutes each way which is subject to local traffic conditions on the day. The last shuttle bus from drop off/pick up point to Queen Anne will be at 8.00pm. There will be a limited wheelchair accessible shuttle service operating throughout the day. Please understand that there may be queues at peak periods of travel and seating is on a first come, first-served basis. Please note that we will not be able to accommodate everybody on the last bus, so we ask that you plan your day accordingly.

### Ship's Security and Safety Notice in Málaga

Whilst many thousands of tourists visit Málaga each year without incident, we would like to remind you about the ongoing threat caused by pickpockets in the port and town.

There are a few simple things that will reduce the chances of you becoming a victim of crime.

- Please do not carry high value items.
- Always zip / close your bags.
- Do not take all your bank or credit cards with you.
- Keep a close eye on any bag (backpack / handbag) whilst eating in restaurants. Try and keep all your belongings within view.
- Avoid items which easily identify you as a tourist.
- Leave your passport on the ship.

Your safety and security are always our prime concern when you are on board the ship. Whilst the chances of you being affected by pickpockets is slim it is important for us that you are aware of this localised issue and remain vigilant.

Thank you for your attention to this matter and we hope you enjoy your time ashore.

### Ship's Security Notice

In order to prevent unauthorised persons boarding the ship, you are required to carry your guest identification card with you when going ashore.

You will be asked to produce this at the gangway when you leave and return to the ship. Be aware that we have established a secure area around the vessel and our security procedures require that you must be prepared to show your guest identification card when entering this area, in addition to showing it to the Security Staff at the gangway when leaving or boarding the ship.

We kindly ask you not to accept and bring on board any parcels or packages from strangers. Before boarding the ship, you may also be asked by our Security Staff to open parcels or handbags which you are carrying. We are sure that you will appreciate that this security is in the best interest of all concerned.

**Currency:** Legal tender in Málaga is the Euro (EUR). Foreign exchange is available from the Purser's Office on Deck 1, Grand Lobby. Queen Anne deals in US Dollars.

**Postage:** Postcards and letters can be posted via the Purser's Office. The postage cost in Málaga is \$3.00 per postcard/letter. If you already have a stamp on your letter or postcard we can still post it for you at the Purser's Office. This facility will close at 2.00pm and any post received after this time will only be posted in the following port.

### Spanish VAT (IVA)

Following changes in European VAT Regulations, Spanish IVA (VAT) at a rate of 10%, is applicable on all bar charges, select dining cover charges and room service charges whilst our ships are located in Spanish territorial waters, (i.e. during the times when we are entering and exiting Spanish ports as well as the time we are alongside in Spanish ports). Prices displayed in our bars, restaurants and room service menus are exclusive of this tax and therefore an additional 10% will be added to all bar charges, select dining cover charges and room service charges whilst our ships are in Spanish territorial waters. The Spanish IVA (VAT) element will be itemised separately on your receipt.

### Prohibited items on balconies

For safety reasons and to protect and preserve the marine environment, no towels or any other personal belongings are to be left on the balcony when the stateroom occupants are not present.
