

Smoking policy

For the safety, comfort and enjoyment of our guests, smoking (including electronic alternatives) is not permitted in staterooms, on stateroom balconies or in public rooms. You will find a designated smoking area on Deck 14, portside, forward of the Sky Bar, accessed via Forward stairway. Smokers should not drift beyond this point. The only exception to this is Churchill's Cigar Lounge, which is reserved for cigar and pipe smokers only. This policy is designed through direct feedback from our guests and is for the safety and comfort of all guests.

How to keep healthy on board

Casino Admission

Guests are reminded that according to current UK legislation, persons under the age of 18 are not permitted to gamble or be present on the Casino floor. Casino area may be used as a walk-through. Proof of age may be required prior to service. Guests who prefer not to participate in Casino gaming may register with Casino Manager or Casino Cashier. On-board spending money cannot be used in the Casino or for any Bingo purchases.

It is a maritime requirement that all guests attend their Assembly Station for familiarisation purposes prior to the Captain's Emergency Procedure Broadcast at 4.30pm. Please visit your Assembly Station on Deck 2 where your Voyage Card or boarding pass will be scanned to record your attendance. Your allocated Assembly Station is as indicated on the back of your stateroom door, on your boarding pass and Voyage card. There is no need to take your life jacket with you. We ask that all guests to watch the Cunard safety video which will be on your stateroom television.

Luggage delivery

Your luggage will be delivered directly to your stateroom/suite. Please be aware that this process takes a considerable amount of time and we ask for your patience and understanding. It is not unusual for bags within the same party to be separated so please do not be alarmed if only some of your luggage pieces arrive. Please report any luggage problems to the Purser's Office.

Alcohol Policy

Guests who are under 18 years of age are not permitted to purchase or consume alcohol on board. However, while in U.S. waters, Cunard enforces and abides by the U.S. legal drinking age of 21 years.

What to Wear: Smart Attire

From 6.00pm on board, we request you wear collared shirt and trousers, top and skirt or stylish trousers, or a dress. It should be noted that the dress code will be enforced in the Britannia Restaurants and Britannia Club as well as Queens Grill and Princess Grill. Some Bar locations also require that the dress code be followed. Of course, if you prefer to spend tonight in more relaxed attire, a selection of casual dining and entertainment venues (Artisans' Foodhall, The Pavilion, Golden Lion and Bright Lights Society) are available for your enjoyment.

Please note non-ripped, jeans are appropriate, but please refrain from wearing shorts, sports attire, swim wear or sleeveless t-shirts outside of the gym, spa and deck spaces.

Britannia Restaurant/Britannia Club seating enquiries

Britannia Club, Deck 2 (Club guests only) and Britannia Restaurant, Deck 2 will be open from 2.00 pm to 4.00pm for seating enquiries. A seating card will be placed in your stateroom or suite during embarkation. Kindly note that table assignments have been allocated by the fare type and the date you booked your voyage; the Maitre d'Hôtel will be following the company policy. Please refer to your booking terms and conditions. Guests who have selected Early or Late Dining are kindly asked to use the Britannia Restaurant Deck 2 (lower level) only. Should you wish to join guests on the Open Dining during your voyage, please inform the Maitre d'Hôtel in advance. Guests who have selected Open Dining are politely requested to use only the Britannia Restaurant Deck 3 (Upper level) during dinner service.

Guests under 18 years of age are not permitted to enter the venue after 11.30pm, Please be aware that proof of age by means of government issued photographic identification, may be requested.
