Captain Andrew Hall started his seagoing career in 1991, at the age of 19, as a Deck Officer Cadet with the Royal Fleet Auxiliary, initially on board the Fleet Replenishment Tanker RFA Tidespring. In 1996 he joined his first passenger ship, the SS Canberra, as Third Officer and has since risen through all ranks across the ships of P&O Cruises, Princess Cruises, and Cunard Line. Andrew's first ship with Cunard was Queen Elizabeth 2 (QE2) in 2005 as Chief Officer, later as one of her last Deputy Captains, before joining Queen Victoria as her first Deputy Captain in 2007. Promoted to Master in 2016, Andrew has since held command of various P&O Cruises ships, Cunard's Queen Victoria, and since 2020, has been immensely proud to be in command of Queen Mary 2. Home is in the small town of Hatherleigh, West Devon, England. Andrew is married to Jenny, who is originally from Malmö in Sweden. They have two daughters, Anja 11 and Clara 9.

Postage: Postcards and letters can be posted via the Purser's Office. The postage cost is US\$2.15 per postcard/letter. If you already have a stamp on your letter or postcard we can still post it for you at the Purser's Office.

Assembly Station familiarisation

It is a maritime requirement that all guests attend their Assembly Station, for familiarisation purposes. If you have not already done so, please visit your Assembly Station, where your Voyage card will be scanned to record your attendance. Your allocated Assembly Station, is as indicated on the back of your stateroom door, boarding pass, and Voyage card. There is no need to take your life jacket with you. We ask that all guests watch the Cunard safety video on their stateroom television, channel 23.

What to Wear: Smart Attire

From 6.00pm on board, we request you wear collared shirt and trousers, top and skirt or stylish trousers, or a dress. Of course, if you prefer to spend tonight in more relaxed attire, a selection of casual dining and entertainment venues are available for your enjoyment. Feel free to dress casually as you visit any of the following venues: Kings Court, Golden Lion, Casino, Carinthia Lounge, and G32. Please note non-ripped, jeans are appropriate, but please refrain from wearing shorts, sports attire, swim wear or sleeveless t-shirts outside of the gym, spa and deck spaces.

Britannia Restaurant seating enquiries

The Britannia Restaurant, Deck 2 entrance, will be open from 1.30pm to 3.00pm for seating enquiries. A seating card will be placed in your stateroom or suite during embarkation. Kindly note that table assignments have been allocated by the fare type and the date you booked your voyage; the Maitre d'Hôtel will be following the company policy. Please refer to your booking terms and conditions. Guests who have selected Early or Late Dining are kindly asked to use the Britannia Restaurant Deck 2 (lower level) only. Should you wish to join guests on the Open Dining during your voyage, please inform the Maitre d'Hôtel in advance. Guests who have selected Open Dining are politely requested to use only the Britannia Restaurant Deck 3 (Upper level) during dinner service.

Environmental

Alcohol policy

Guests under 18 years of age are not permitted to purchase or consume alcohol on board. However, while in US waters, Cunard enforces and abides by the US legal drinking age of 21 years.

Internet assistance
