Queen Mary 2 has continued her southerly course, now passing the mouth of the Bay of Biscay and leaving the coastlines of France and northern Spain behind. As we make our way towards the Iberian Peninsula, we are approaching the Finisterre Traffic Separation Scheme, which lies off the northwest coast of Spain. This busy maritime route ensures safe passage as vessels navigate the waters around Cape Finisterre. After rounding the cape, Queen Mary 2 will alter course to the south. This will take us down the west coast of Portugal, where we will maintain a steady course towards Lisbon, picking up the local pilot in the early morning hours.

## For your information

### What to Wear: Smart Attire

From 6.00pm on board, we request you wear collared shirt and trousers, top and skirt or stylish trousers, or a dress. Of course, if you prefer to spend tonight in more relaxed attire, a selection of casual dining and entertainment venues are available for your enjoyment. Feel free to dress casually as you visit any of the following venues: Kings Court, Golden Lion Pub, Casino, Carinthia Lounge, and G32. Please note non-ripped, jeans are appropriate, but please refrain from wearing shorts, sports attire, swim wear or sleeveless t-shirts outside of the gym, spa and deck spaces.

### Alcohol policy

Guests who are under 18 years of age are not permitted to purchase or consume alcohol on board. However, while in US waters, Cunard enforces and abides by the US legal drinking age of 21 years. You may be asked for proof of government identification.

### Deck chairs

Deck chairs operate on a first-come, first-served basis and cannot be reserved. For the consideration of all guests, please ensure you take your belongings when leaving a deck chair for a period of 30 minutes, or they will be removed and taken to the Purser's Office for collection.

### Internet assistance

For any guests seeking guidance and help for the on board Wi-Fi or My Voyage app, there will be assistance in ConneXions 1, Deck 2, Stairway A from 9.00am to 12.00pm and 3.00pm to 5.00pm. Alternatively, a step-by-step guide can also be found in the My Voyage Guide located in your stateroom should these venues be busy at peak time.

### Prohibited items on balconies

For safety reasons and to protect and preserve the marine environment, no towels or any other personal belongings are to be left on the balcony when the stateroom occupants are not present.

### Ship's security and safety notice in Lisbon

Whilst thousands of tourists visit Lisbon each year without incident, we would like to remind you about the ongoing threat caused by pickpockets. Pickpockets like busy areas because they may operate undetected due to the general commotion. Therefore, exercise caution when taking public transportation, going to crowded marketplaces, or visiting any of the island's numerous tourist destinations.

There are a few simple things that will reduce the chances of you becoming a victim of crime:

- Please do not carry high value items.
- Always zip or close your bags.
- Do not take all your bank or credit cards with you.
- Keep a close eye on any bag (backpack/handbag) while eating in restaurants. Try and keep them within view.
- Avoid items which easily identify you as a tourist.
- Leave your passport on the ship, unless required as a form of identification by the port officials.

Your safety and security are always our prime concern when you are on board the ship. While the chances of you being affected by pickpockets is slim, it is important for us that you are aware of this localised issue and remain vigilant.

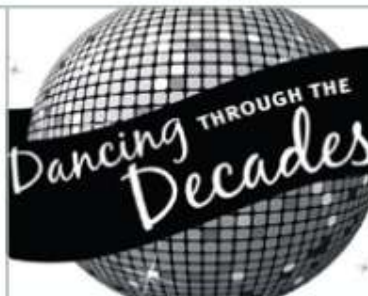
