Port Highlights



As the capital of Portugal, Lisbon triumphantly spreads its welcoming city atmosphere and its several impressive ancient sites over the seven steep hillsides that overlook the Tagus Estuary and River. Just a brief stroll along the tangled streets that wind around Lisbon's hills is enough to appreciate the city's history. Lisbon is one of the oldest cities in the world, its origins traceable to 1200 BC. Among its rooftops, Gothic towers and decadent domes burst from a sea of red-tiled buildings, while at ground level you will see elegant shops, graceful palacios, and ancient ruins. Lively marketplaces and bountiful pastelarias feed the city, while Lisbon's many cool fountains and leafy parks provide shade for locals and visitors. Though the city has evolved much over the centuries, it is easy to see why it has endured for so long. Straddling the shore where the river Tagus meets the Atlantic, Lisbon is home to fascinating museums and galleries, superb shopping, and beautiful architecture. See the city by Tuk Tuk, or climb aboard one of its historic trams. The National Coach Museum is among the most popular Lisbon attractions, offering an unrivalled collection of historical carriages. Museu Coleção Berardo boasts an impressive art collection, including works by Picasso and Jackson Pollock. The viewpoint at Miradouro da Graça provides truly dramatic and far-reaching views, while the tranquil Mário Soares Garden is a veritable oasis in the heart of Lisbon's bustling centre.

What to Wear: Smart Attire

From 6.00pm on board, we request you wear collared shirt and trousers, top and skirt or stylish trousers, or a dress. Of course, if you prefer to spend tonight in more relaxed attire, a selection of casual dining and entertainment venues are available for your enjoyment.

Feel free to dress casually as you visit any of the following venues: Kings Court, Golden Lion Pub, Casino, Carinthia Lounge, and G32. Please note non-ripped, jeans are appropriate, but please refrain from wearing shorts, sports attire, swim wear or sleeveless t-shirts outside of the gym, spa and deck spaces.

Alcohol policy

Guests who are under 18 years of age are not permitted to purchase or consume alcohol on board. However, while in US waters, Cunard enforces and abides by the US legal drinking age of 21 years. You may be asked for government identification.

Essential routine maintenance

Routine maintenance is currently being conducted in various areas of Queen Mary 2 to ensure its upkeep. We apologise for any inconvenience caused and thank you for your understanding.

Prohibited items on balconies

For safety reasons and to protect and preserve the marine environment, no towels or any other personal belongings are to be left on the balcony when the stateroom occupants are not present.

Ship's security and safety notice in Lisbon

Whilst thousands of tourists visit Lisbon each year without incident, we would like to remind you about the ongoing threat caused by pickpockets. Pickpockets like busy areas because they may operate undetected due to the general commotion.

Therefore, exercise caution when taking public transportation, going to crowded marketplaces, or visiting any of the island's numerous tourist destinations.

There are a few simple things that will reduce the chances of you becoming a victim of crime:

- Please do not carry high value items.
- Always zip or close your bags.
- Do not take all your bank or credit cards with you.
- Keep a close eye on any bag (backpack/handbag) while eating in restaurants. Try and keep them within view.
- Avoid items which easily identify you as a tourist.
- Leave your passport on the ship, unless required as a form of identification by the port officials.

Your safety and security are always our prime concern when you are on board the ship. While the chances of you being affected by pickpockets is slim, it is important for us that you are aware of this localised issue and remain vigilant.

Ship's security notice

In order to prevent unauthorised persons boarding the ship, you are required to carry your Voyage card with you when going ashore. You will be asked to produce this at the gangway when you leave and return to the ship.

Be aware that we have established a secure area around the vessel and our security procedures require that you must be prepared to show your Voyage card when entering this area, in addition to showing it to the Security Staff at the gangway when leaving or boarding the ship. We kindly ask you not to accept and bring on board any parcels or packages from strangers.

Before boarding the ship, you may also be asked by our Security Staff to open parcels or handbags which you are carrying. We are sure that you will appreciate that this security is in the best interest of all concerned.

Shore Experiences

All the shore experiences will be meeting on the quayside, in front of the cruise terminal building. When you exit the cruise terminal building, you go to the left where the coaches will be waiting for you. It is a good 10 to 15 minutes walk from the gangway to the shore experiences buses.

Please listen to the arrival announcement for the gangway location. We kindly ask you to only proceed ashore at the meeting time indicated for your shore experience. On the pier, there is no shelter from the sun or seats available to wait.

Wheelchair assistance

Limited complimentary shuttle service

There will be a limited shuttle service reserved for those guests that cannot walk the approximate 10 to 20 minute walk to reach the city centre.

The shuttle service will start at 8.00am, and the last shuttle back to Queen Mary 2 will be at 4.30pm. The journey time is approximately 40 minutes, depending on the traffic. At peak hours, queues are expected, alternative taxis will be available.
