

# Port Highlights



Step off your ship and into a little piece of Portuguese paradise in the archipelago of Madeira, in the Atlantic Ocean. Enchanting towns and villages, breathtaking landscapes, a spectacular array of unique flora, and delicious local wines are awaiting your discovery on a cruise to the Portuguese islands of Madeira. You will dock in the capital city of Funchal, an area bustling with bars and restaurants that radiate local charm. From here, you can explore further into the unique Madeira countryside, where imposing mountainous slopes give way to luscious rainforests and vast moorlands. Madeira sits off the north-western coast of Africa, a little further north than its popular neighbours, the Canary Islands. An archipelago comprising four small islands, the capital port city of Funchal sits on Madeira's largest island, a land teeming with visual, culinary, and experiential delights. Funchal port lies just over a mile and a half from the city centre, and is situated on the south of the island. From here, you can spend time exploring the stunning botanical gardens, lounge on pebbly beaches, or take a trip further inland to experience a unique landscape that seems to shift every few miles.

Currency: The currency used in Funchal, Madeira, is the Euro (€). Euros are available on board. There are plenty of ATMs across the island as well as currency exchanges in the port terminal. Foreign exchange is available from the Purser's Office located on Deck 2 in the Grand Lobby. Queen Mary 2 deals in US\$ Dollars.

**Postage:** Postcards and letters can be posted via the Purser's Office. The postage cost is US\$3.00 per postcard/letter. If you already have a stamp on your letter or postcard we can still post it for you at the Purser's Office. This service will close at 1.00pm tomorrow.

# For your information

#### What to Wear: Smart Attire

From 6.00 pm on board, we request you wear collared shirt and trousers, top and skirt or stylish trousers, or a dress. Of course, if you prefer to spend tonight in more relaxed attire, a selection of casual dining and entertainment venues are available for your enjoyment.

Feel free to dress casually as you visit any of the following venues: Kings Court, Golden Lion Pub, Casino, Carinthia Lounge, and G32. Please note non-ripped, jeans are appropriate, but please refrain from wearing shorts, sports attire, swim wear or sleeveless t-shirts outside of the gym, spa and deck spaces.

## Alcohol policy

Guests who are under 18 years of age are not permitted to purchase or consume alcohol on board. However, while in US waters, Cunard enforces and abides by the US legal drinking age of 21 years. You may be asked for government identification.

#### Hand washing and sanitising

To stay healthy, please wash your hands regularly with soap and water and use the hand sanitisers around the ship. Should you experience any symptoms of respiratory or gastrointestinal illness, please immediately return to your stateroom and notify the medical staff by phoning 999 or 911.

#### Tennis court maintenance

The tennis court, Deck 13, Stairway B, will be closed from today, Thursday, 20 February 2025, until Monday, 24 February 2025, due to essential maintenance taking place. We apologise for any inconvenience caused and thank you for your understanding.

#### Prohibited items on balconies

For safety reasons and to protect and preserve the marine environment, no towels or any other personal belongings are to be left on the balcony when the stateroom occupants are not present.

#### Smoking policy

For the safety, comfort, and enjoyment of our guests, smoking (including electronic alternatives) is not permitted in staterooms, on stateroom balconies, or in public rooms. You will find a designated smoking area on Deck 8, aft, port side, immediately outside the entrance onto the deck only. Smokers should not drift beyond this point.

The only exception to this is Churchill's Cigar Lounge, which is reserved for cigar and pipe smokers only. This policy is designed through direct feedback from our guests and is for the safety and comfort of all guests.

### Your security and safety ashore this voyage

Whilst we do not wish to restrict your movements ashore today and in our upcoming ports, we do suggest taking the following precautions:

- . Do not stray from the main tourist areas
- Do not wear any jewellery that is likely to attract attention
- Be careful to secure personal possessions in pockets, wallets and handbags as pickpockets can
  operate in all cities
- We advise you to be careful if you are taking any high value items, including cameras, ashore.
- Maintain an awareness of your surroundings at all times

#### Ship's security notice

In order to prevent unauthorised persons boarding the ship, you are required to carry your Voyage card with you when going ashore. You will be asked to produce this at the gangway when you leave and return to the ship.

Be aware that we have established a secure area around the vessel and our security procedures require that you must be prepared to show your Voyage card when entering this area, in addition to showing it to the Security Staff at the gangway when leaving or boarding the ship.

We kindly ask you not to accept and bring on board any parcels or packages from strangers. Before boarding the ship, you may also be asked by our Security Staff to open parcels or handbags which you are carrying. We are sure that you will appreciate that this security is in the best interest of all concerned.

# Shore Experiences

All shore experiences will be meeting ashore in front of the cruise terminal in the bus parking area. When you exit the gangway, go to the left; there is a small gate that will be open, and you will proceed through that gate where the parking area is and where the shore experiences buses will be waiting for you.

Please note it may be necessary to walk some distance to reach your mode of transport for your designated shore experience. We do offer water for purchase in our bars during the advertised opening hours.

#### Wheelchair assistance

Guests are kindly reminded that wheelchair assistance, if required, will be provided to assist guests on and off the gangway only. As per the terms and conditions stated in the Cunard brochure, guests must be able to make their own way to the transportation on the pier or be accompanied by a travel companion who is able to assist them.

#### Complimentary shuttle bus service

There will be a complimentary shuttle bus transfer service between Queen Mary 2 and Pier 8, which is close by the cable car. The first bus will depart at 8.00am. The shuttle bus transfer will take approximately 15 to 20 minutes each way and is subject to local traffic conditions on the day. The last shuttle bus to return to Queen Mary 2 will be at 10.00pm. There will also be a wheelchair-accessible bus in the rotation from 9.00am until 10.00pm. The shuttle bus service will commence at 8.00am tomorrow morning.

Please understand that there may be queues at peak periods of travel, and seating is on a first-come, first-served basis. We will not be able to accommodate everybody on the last bus, so we ask that you plan your day accordingly.
