

# Port Highlights



An idyllic land rich in breathtaking natural treasures. Explore rugged volcanic landscapes, picturesque villages, and black sand beaches, peppered between vast swathes of emerald green forests and national parks. An often-overlooked gem, La Palma is an unmissable stop on any Canary Island voyage. Fondly referred to as "La Isla Verde" (the green island) and "La Isla Bonita" (the beautiful island), La Palma is smaller than many of its popular neighbouring islands, but it holds no less natural splendour. The most northwestern of the Canary Islands, La Palma is just 706 square kilometres in size, making it an ideal size for guests hungry to explore much of what the island has to offer in a day. Tucked away along the east coast of the island lies the capital city and port town of Santa Cruz de La Palma. A relaxed ambience greets you as you step ashore into this delightfully sleepy town. Catch your first glimpse of the dramatic landscape beyond the harbour, with mountainous ridges rising up over 2,000 metres in the distance, while the town's cobbled streets, quaint cafés, and abundant boutiques beckon. Top landmarks and sights in Santa Cruz de La Palma are Calle O'Daly, Avenida Maritima, Plaza de la Alameda, and Playa de Bajamar. La Palma is a nature lovers' paradise, with lush greenery, Martian-like volcanic peaks. and endless trails to explore. There is so much to see and do like the La Palma Observatory, Caldera de Taburiente National Park, Fuencaliente, and Laurel forests. Boasting a rich culinary heritage, cuisine on La Palma pulls inspiration from traditional Spanish, African and Latin American dishes. La Palma is known for its local craftspeople and their expertise in producing ceramics, woodworks and various textiles which guests can find at local boutiques, markets and souvenir shops.

# For your information

#### What to Wear: Smart Attire

From 6.00 pm on board, we request you wear collared shirt and trousers, top and skirt or stylish trousers, or a dress. Of course, if you prefer to spend tonight in more relaxed attire, a selection of casual dining and entertainment venues are available for your enjoyment.

Feel free to dress casually as you visit any of the following venues: Kings Court, Golden Lion Pub, Casino, Carinthia Lounge, and G32. Please note non-ripped, Jeans are appropriate, but please refrain from wearing shorts, sports attire, swim wear or sleeveless t-shirts outside of the gym, spa and deck spaces.

## Alcohol policy

Guests who are under 18 years of age are not permitted to purchase or consume alcohol on board. However, while in US waters, Cunard enforces and abides by the US legal drinking age of 21 years. You may be asked for government identification.

## Crew emergency drill

At 10.00am this morning, alarms will be sounded and broadcasts made as the crew are exercised in their emergency duties. During this exercise, limited guest services will be provided. You are advised that part of the exercise involves checking guest staterooms to ensure that they have been evacuated.

If you prefer not to be disturbed, please display the "Privacy Please" notice prior to the start of the drill. For the duration of the crew drill, we kindly request that guests please keep clear of the outside area of the boat deck.

#### Hand washing and sanitising

To stay healthy, please wash your hands regularly with soap and water and use the hand sanitisers around the ship. Should you experience any symptoms of respiratory or gastrointestinal illness, please immediately return to your stateroom and notify the medical staff by phoning 999 or 911.

#### Tennis court maintenance

The tennis court, Deck 13, Stairway B, will be closed until Monday, 24 February 2025, due to essential maintenance taking place. We apologise for any inconvenience caused and thank you for your understanding.

#### Prohibited items on balconies

For safety reasons and to protect and preserve the marine environment, no towels or any other personal belongings are to be left on the balcony when the stateroom occupants are not present.

#### Your security and safety ashore this voyage

Whilst we do not wish to restrict your movements ashore today and in our upcoming ports, we do suggest taking the following precautions:

- · Do not stray from the main tourist areas
- · Do not wear any jewellery that is likely to attract attention
- Be careful to secure personal possessions in pockets, wallets and handbags as pickpockets can
  operate in all cities
- · We advise you to be careful if you are taking any high value items, including cameras, ashore
- · Maintain an awareness of your surroundings at all times

#### Ship's security notice

In order to prevent unauthorised persons boarding the ship, you are required to carry your Voyage card with you when going ashore. You will be asked to produce this at the gangway when you leave and return to the ship.

Be aware that we have established a secure area around the vessel and our security procedures require that you must be prepared to show your Voyage card when entering this area, in addition to showing it to the Security Staff at the gangway when leaving or boarding the ship.

We kindly ask you not to accept and bring on board any parcels or packages from strangers. Before boarding the ship, you may also be asked by our Security Staff to open parcels or handbags which you are carrying. We are sure that you will appreciate that this security is in the best interest of all concerned.

#### Wheelchair assistance

## Limited complimentary shuttle service

A limited shuttle bus service will be in operation for guests with reduced mobility between Queen Mary 2 and the Port Gate.

The first shuttle bus will depart at 8.00am from the ship, and the transfer time is approximately 5 minutes each way. The last shuttle bus from the drop-off/pick-up point to Queen Mary 2 will be at 7.00pm. Guests are allowed to walk to the port gate, and the distance is approximately 700 metres.
