Port Highlights



Nestled in a natural harbour on the northeast coast of the island, the port sits less than a kilometre from the main town square, Plaza de Espana. Its location makes it easy for you to branch off and experience the wonders that the island of Tenerife has to offer, but the port has an enchanting presence in itself too. It is full of brightly painted buildings and rich, historical architecture, as well as plentiful shops, restaurants, and cafés. Spend an afternoon strolling through the Palmetum, a 30-acre botanical garden that plays host to the most pristine palm tree collection in Europe, as well as over 200 more tropical and subtropical plant species. The gardens are also a haven for birdwatchers, with blackbirds, blue tits, hoopoes, and many other aviary species. An impressive peak rising over 12,000 feet above sea level, perhaps ascend the iconic Mount Teide, the third-tallest volcanic structure in the world. There are many ways to experience the beauty of this active volcano, which is found within the UNESCO World Heritage Site, the Teide National Park. Choose from several hiking trails, a cable car ride, an observatory, and an astronomy tower for the best views. Santa Cruz de Tenerife is home to numerous squares and plazas from which you can take a moment to relax and watch the world pass by. Should you be looking for a slow-paced day on the beach, you will find no shortage of blissful bays to choose from in Tenerife, from the volcanic black sands of Playa del Ancón to the golden shores of Playa de Las Teresitas. For a more active experience, maybe take a trip to the eastern side of the island to gaze at the ancient Pyramids of Güímar. Adventure seekers can enjoy a day in Siam Park, one of the world's most famous water parks, and avid animal lovers should visit nearby Loro Parque Zoo.

What to Wear: Smart Attire

From 6.00pm on board, we request you wear collared shirt and trousers, top and skirt or stylish trousers, or a dress. Of course, if you prefer to spend tonight in more relaxed attire, a selection of casual dining and entertainment venues are available for your enjoyment.

Please note non-ripped, jeans are appropriate, but please refrain from wearing shorts, sports attire, swim wear or sleeveless t-shirts outside of the gym, spa and deck spaces.

Alcohol policy

Guests who are under 18 years of age are not permitted to purchase or consume alcohol on board. However, while in US waters, Cunard enforces and abides by the US legal drinking age of 21 years. You may be asked for government identification.

Deck chairs

Deck chairs operate on a first-come, first-served basis and cannot be reserved. For the consideration of all guests, please ensure you take your belongings when leaving a deck chair for a period of 30 minutes, or they will be removed and taken to the Purser's Office for collection.

Essential routine maintenance

Routine maintenance is currently being conducted in various areas of Queen Mary 2 to ensure its upkeep. We apologise for any inconvenience caused and thank you for your understanding.

Hand washing and sanitising

To stay healthy, please wash your hands regularly with soap and water and use the hand sanitisers around the ship. Should you experience any symptoms of respiratory or gastrointestinal illness, please immediately return to your stateroom and notify the medical staff by phoning 999 or 911.

Prohibited items on balconies

For safety reasons and to protect and preserve the marine environment, no towels or any other personal belongings are to be left on the balcony when the stateroom occupants are not present.

Ship's security and safety notice in Tenerife

Whilst thousands of tourists visit Tenerife each year without incident, we would like to remind you about the ongoing threat caused by pickpockets. Pickpockets like busy areas because they may operate undetected due to the general commotion.

Therefore, exercise caution when taking public transportation, going to crowded marketplaces, or visiting any of the island's numerous tourist destinations.

There are a few simple things that will reduce the chances of you becoming a victim of crime:

- Please do not carry high value items.
- Always zip or close your bags.
- Do not take all your bank or credit cards with you.
- Keep a close eye on any bag (backpack/handbag) while eating in restaurants. Try and keep them within view.
- Avoid items which easily identify you as a tourist.
- Leave your passport on the ship, unless required as a form of identification by the port officials.

Your safety and security are always our prime concern when you are on board the ship. While the chances of you being affected by pickpockets is slim, it is important for us that you are aware of this localised issue and remain vigilant.

Ship's security notice

In order to prevent unauthorised persons boarding the ship, you are required to carry your Voyage card with you when going ashore. You will be asked to produce this at the gangway when you leave and return to the ship.

Be aware that we have established a secure area around the vessel and our security procedures require that you must be prepared to show your Voyage card when entering this area, in addition to showing it to the Security Staff at the gangway when leaving or boarding the ship.

We kindly ask you not to accept and bring on board any parcels or packages from strangers. Before boarding the ship, you may also be asked by our Security Staff to open parcels or handbags which you are carrying. We are sure that you will appreciate that this security is in the best interest of all concerned.

Wheelchair assistance

Guests are kindly reminded that wheelchair assistance, if required, will be provided to assist guests on and off the gangway only. As per the terms and conditions stated in the Cunard brochure, guests must be able to make their own way to the transportation on the pier or be accompanied by a travel companion who is able to assist them.

Complimentary port shuttle bus service

A complimentary port shuttle service will be in operation between the ship and the exit of the port gates, the city access bridge, which is at the start of the entrance to the city. The first bus will depart at 8.00am. The shuttle bus transfer will take approximately 10 to 15 minutes each way, depending on the traffic. The last departure from the city will be at 5.00pm.

There will be a wheelchair-accessible bus in the rotation from 8.15am until 5.15pm.

At peak hours, queues are expected. As an alternative, taxis will be available.
