Port Highlights

Historic, mysterious, and romantic, the Spanish city of Cádiz is unlike any other. Founded in about 1100 BC, it is generally accepted as the oldest continuously inhabited settlement in today's Europe. But for the thin strip connecting it to the mainland to its south, Cádiz is an island of history and architecture that impresses at every turn through the streets of this charming ancient port. You will find a complex warren of streets, bustling bars, and pretty beaches; it is difficult to know what to do or where to go first. Packed with historic sites, monuments, and an excellent museum of art and archaeology, Cádiz is a draw for history buffs and those attracted by the arts. To begin with, consider a visit to the Catedral de Cádiz, an elegant, baroque-neoclassical, yellow-domed cathedral. Admire the view from the Campo del Sur as the sun goes down to see a breathtaking array of colours. Outside the cathedral, you will find the sizeable Casa del Obispo museum. It is on the site of 1,640 square yards of excavated ruins and helps to bring to life the colourful history of Cádiz. Cádiz is home to one of Spain's most famous carnivals, Los Carnavales. Roaring on for two weeks, this carnival is distinctive due to its celebration of the clever, the witty, and the irreverent. Rehearsals and contests are held throughout the year, meaning that in Cádiz, the carnival feels omnipresent. When you are ready to relax after all that heat, head to one of Cádiz's many beautiful beaches. Try Playa de la Victoria, a spacious beach with a happy and relaxed vibe and easy transport links. It is just over half a mile south of the Puerta de Tierra and stretches 2.5 miles along the peninsula. Whether you want to sit back and enjoy the weather or try your hand at some water sports, you can do it all here. You may also want to visit La Caleta: this pretty beach is sandwiched between two castles, Castillo de Santa Catalina and Castillo de San Sebastian. Make sure to pick up some seafood by the beach, as it is some of the best in Spain.

Currency: The currency used in Cádiz and throughout Spain is the Euro (€). Euros are available on board. Foreign exchange is available from the Purser's Office located on Deck 2 in the Grand Lobby. Queen Mary 2 deals in US\$ Dollars.

Postage: Postcards and letters can be posted via the Purser's Office. The postage cost is US\$3.00 per postcard/letter. If you already have a stamp on your letter or postcard we can still post it for you at the Purser's Office. This service will close at 3.00pm.

What to Wear: Smart Attire

From 6.00pm on board, we request you wear collared shirt and trousers, top and skirt or stylish trousers, or a dress. Of course, if you prefer to spend tonight in more relaxed attire, a selection of casual dining and entertainment venues are available for your enjoyment. Feel free to dress casually as you visit any of the following venues: Kings Court, Golden Lion Pub, Casino, Carinthia Lounge, and G32. Please note non-ripped, jeans are appropriate, but please refrain from wearing shorts, sports attire, swim wear or sleeveless t-shirts outside of the gym, spa and deck spaces.

Alcohol policy

Guests who are under 18 years of age are not permitted to purchase or consume alcohol on board. However, while in US waters, Cunard enforces and abides by the US legal drinking age of 21 years. You may be asked for government identification.

Hand washing and sanitising

To stay healthy, please wash your hands regularly with soap and water and use the hand sanitisers around the ship. Should you experience any symptoms of respiratory or gastrointestinal illness, please immediately return to your stateroom and notify the medical staff by phoning 999 or 911.

Prohibited items on balconies

For safety reasons and to protect and preserve the marine environment, no towels or any other personal belongings are to be left on the balcony when the stateroom occupants are not present.

Preparing for your onward journey

We trust you are having an enjoyable and memorable time on board Queen Mary 2. The Purser's Office will be writing to all guests with important information about the disembarkation plans. All guests will have the option to disembark directly from their stateroom to the gangway at an allocated time, or to request Fast Track disembarkation.

It is important that your allocated time is adhered to, avoiding potential crowds at the gangway area. The Purser's Office are available on extension 22200 to assist with any queries, book mobility assistance and take requests for Fast Track disembarkation.

Fast Track disembarkation spaces are limited and guests will be responsible for carrying all their luggage with them. The registration deadline for Fast Track disembarkation is 10.00pm on the evening before disembarkation.

Ship's security notice

In order to prevent unauthorised persons boarding the ship, you are required to carry your Voyage card with you when going ashore. You will be asked to produce this at the gangway when you leave and return to the ship. Be aware that we have established a secure area around the vessel and our security procedures require that you must be prepared to show your Voyage card when entering this area, in addition to showing it to the Security Staff at the gangway when leaving or boarding the ship. We kindly ask you not to accept and bring on board any parcels or packages from strangers. Before boarding the ship, you may also be asked by our Security Staff to open parcels or handbags which you are carrying. We are sure that you will appreciate that this security is in the best interest of all concerned.

Spanish IVA (VAT)

Following changes in European VAT regulations, Spanish IVA (VAT) at a rate of 10% is applicable on all bar charges, select dining cover charges, and room service charges while our ships are located in Spanish territorial waters, (i.e., during the times when we are entering and exiting Spanish ports as well as the time we are alongside in Spanish ports). Prices displayed in our bars, restaurants, and room service menus are exclusive of this tax, and therefore an additional 10% will be added to all bar charges, select dining cover charges, and room service charges whilst our ships are in Spanish territorial waters. The Spanish IVA (VAT) element will be itemised separately on your receipt.

Your security and safety ashore this voyage

Whilst we do not wish to restrict your movements ashore today, we do suggest taking the following precautions:

- Do not stray from the main tourist areas
- Do not wear any jewellery that is likely to attract attention
- Be careful to secure personal possessions in pockets, wallets and handbags as pickpockets can operate in all cities
- We advise you to be careful if you are taking any high value items, including cameras, ashore
- Maintain an awareness of your surroundings at all times
