From the Navigator



Today Queen Mary 2 will pass through the Ushant Traffic Separation Scheme and into the English Channel, later this evening we will transit through the Casquets Traffic Separation Scheme. During this time, we will pass approximately 13 miles from Casquets Lighthouse, which was built in 1724 upon the dangerous rocks off Alderney after shipowners petitioned the proprietor of the rocks. The concerned shipowners offered Thomas Le Cocq a ½ penny per ton of vessel when passing the proposed lighthouse. Le Cocq approached Trinity House, and a patent was obtained on 3 June 1723.

The King's Trust Silent Chart Auction

It shows the route taken this voyage and is signed by Captain Aseem A. Hashmi MNM and the Navigational Team. Alcohol policy

Guests who are under 18 years of age are not permitted to purchase or consume alcohol on board. However, while in US waters, Cunard enforces and abides by the US legal drinking age of 21 years. You may be asked for proof of government identification.

Cash payments

For guests disembarking in Southampton on Saturday, 1 March 2025, please note the deadline of 10.00pm, today for the following services:

- Making a cash payment. After this deadline, all charges will be settled to the registered credit card. Please be advised that no cash will be refunded to your credit card.
- Charging cash back and/or foreign exchange to your on board account. Cash for cash foreign exchange facilities/transactions are available until the time of disembarkation on Saturday, 1 March 2025. Please note that failure to settle your account will result in delays to your disembarkation.

Cash out reminder

A friendly reminder to all our guests to cash out all of your casino winnings, chips, and slot machine credits before the casino closes tonight as this will not transfer automatically to your on board account. This applies even if you are continuing onwards.

Prohibited items on balconies

For safety reasons and to protect and preserve the marine environment, no towels or any other personal belongings are to be left on the balcony when the stateroom occupants are not present.

Recycling of Voyage card

United Kingdom Customs Allowance - tax-and duty-free items

Disembarking guests have a United Kingdom customs allowance of 4 litres of spirits and liquors (over 22% volume) or 9 litres of sparkling wine/fortified wine/aperitifs, and additionally 18 litres of wine (not sparkling). You also have an allowance of 200 cigarettes or 50 cigars or 100 cigarillos or 250 grams of tobacco (for guests 17 years of age or older), and you are allowed gifts and souvenirs up to the value of £390.00. If you are in excess of the customs allowance, you must visit the Red Point in the terminal building and declare all articles purchased abroad. If you are in doubt, you should stop at the Red Point before entering the Green Channel on your way to the exit.
