Port Highlights



Situated on the Ionian sea, Katakolon is a picturesque town whose port is lined with colourful houses and several good cafes and restaurants, as well as being home to the Museum of Greek Technology. Most notably, however, the town serves as a gateway to the famous ancient Greek ruins of Olympia, where the Olympics originated in the 7th century BC: here, visitors can see not only an impressive 45,000 seat stadium but also the well-preserved ruins of two temples and a fascinating museum. The area surrounding Katakolon has many wineries, some of which, like the Mercouri Estate, host wine-tasting sessions, as well as two lovely beaches where you can cool off in sparkling turquoise waters. The nearby town of Skafidia also has some worthwhile places to visit, including an interesting monastery.

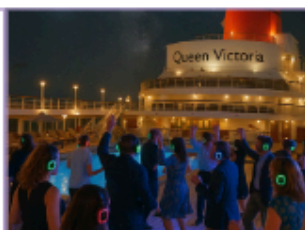

Looking to Exchange Currency? While foreign exchange services are not available on board, you will find convenient options ashore. Our local port representatives have advised that currency exchange facilities are available in the city centre, and ATMs are widely accessible in the port area for withdrawing local currency.

Postage: Postcards and letters weighing less than 50g in weight can be posted via the Purser's Desk on Deck 1 in the Grand Lobby. There is a charge of US\$3.00 for this service. All postage must be in by 3.00pm.

What to Wear: Smart Attire

Effective from 5:30pm, all guests entering the Dining Rooms are required to adhere to the evening dress code. Acceptable attire includes smart collared shirts, evening tops, trousers, skirts, and dresses. Jackets are optional but encouraged. Guests who prefer a more relaxed dress style are welcome to dine at the Lido Restaurant, where casual attire is permitted. Non-ripped jeans are acceptable; however, shorts, sportswear, swimwear, and sleeveless t-shirts are prohibited outside of designated areas such as the gym, spa, and open decks.

Ship's Security Notice

In order to prevent unauthorised persons boarding the ship, you are required to carry your voyage identification card with you when going ashore. You will be asked to produce this at the gangway when you leave and return to the ship. We kindly ask you not to accept and bring on board any parcels or packages from strangers. Before boarding the ship, you may also be asked by our Security Staff to open parcels or handbags which you are carrying. We are sure that you will appreciate that this security is in the best interest of all concerned.

Security and Safety Ashore

Whilst we do not wish to restrict your movements ashore we do suggest taking the following precautions:

- Do not stray from the main tourist areas
- Do not wear any jewellery that is likely to attract attention
- Be careful to secure personal possessions in pockets, wallets and handbags as pickpockets can operate in all cities
- We advise you to be careful if you are taking any high value items, including cameras ashore
- Maintain an awareness of your surroundings at all times.

Natural Sulphur Emissions

Please be advised that a noticeable odor may be present in the area due to natural sulphur emissions at the Port of Katakolon. This is a common occurrence and poses no health risk.

Energy Conservation Notice: Balcony Doors

We kindly ask our guests to avoid leaving your balcony doors open. Excessive warm air affects our ship's air conditioning efficiency. By keeping the doors closed, you contribute to energy efficiency and help maintain a comfortable environment for everyone on board. Please close your balcony door gently as a courtesy of your neighbours. For safety reasons and to protect and preserve the marine environment, no towels or any other personal belongings are to be left on the balcony when the stateroom occupants are not present.

Please be advised that the Queens Room on Deck 2 will be closed from 5.00pm to 7.45pm today due to a private function. Guests are kindly invited to use the alternative decks to transit around the area. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation.



Time Change Notice

Kindly be advised that tomorrow morning, Saturday, 16 May at 2.00am, Queen Victoria's official ship time **will be set back by one hour**. (UTC +2). Therefore, we would recommend that you adjust all timekeeping pieces accordingly before retiring this evening.

Smoking Areas

Smoking is not permitted in all indoor and outdoor public spaces, including stateroom, balconies, apart from designated smoking areas on the starboard side of Decks 3 and 10.
