Queen Victoria's second sea day begins in the Tyrrhenian Sea as we continue our western leg towards Barcelona. We cleared the northern coastline of Sicily in the early hours and thereafter steamed westerly towards the island of Sardinia. At their closest points of approach on this leg, we pass 20 miles south of Sardinia and 70 miles North of Tunisia. Our final leg of this voyage sees us heading north-westerly into the Balearic Sea, and onwards towards our destination of Barcelona

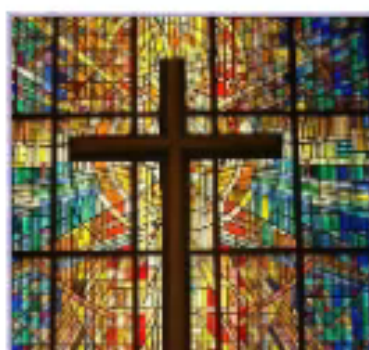

## General Sir Simon Mayall - Military History

### Gallipoli Part Two (Heroism and Sacrifice)



As war raged on the Eastern and Western Fronts, the Allies had a potential opportunity to outflank the carnage of trench warfare, knock the Ottomans out of the war, and open supply routes to Russia. Despite extraordinary heroism and sacrifice by the Allied soldiers, success ultimately eluded them. In this second lecture, General Mayall traces the campaign from the April landings at ANZAC and Helles, through the Suvla Bay operation, to the brilliantly executed evacuations of January 1916, and examines the prospects for success, the reasons for failure, and the aftermath.
